## Clubhouse Small Group Guide

DIY - Week 4 | The Story of The Lost Son

March 22, 2020

**SUMMARY:** In **Luke 15:11-24**, Jesus shares a parable to help people understand God's amazing grace and forgiveness. A son came to his father and asked for his share of the inheritance. This broke the father's heart, but he went ahead and gave the son what he wanted. The son wasted every last penny and hit rock bottom. He decided to go home to his father and ask forgiveness. The father was waiting with arms open wide and ready to have his son home.

**BOTTOM LINE:** **Everyone needs to be forgiven.** Everyone at some point will do something to hurt another person, and we've all done something that goes against what God wants for us. We all need forgiveness. Thankfully, through Jesus, God offers forgiveness no matter what we've done.

### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **When has someone forgiven you?** Perhaps it was when did you something wrong against someone?
- **Who were the main characters? What was today's story about?** The main characters were Jesus' and the parable of the Lost Son. Today's story was about Jesus teaching on forgiveness. About how everyone needs to be forgiven.
- **Why does everyone need to be forgiven?** Because everyone will do something they shouldn't at one point in their life. We all need to forgiveness because we all make mistakes and God forgave us.
- **What can we learn from this?** God's love for us is huge. That love drives God to forgive others when they do something wrong. God can help forgive everyone that has wronged us!

**PRAYER:** Close by asking kids for prayer request and pray about what was learned
