**KIDS BLAST - | Jesus Feeds the Crowd**

**ICE BREAKER QUESTIONS:**

- What is one of your favorite things about a family member?
- What are your favorite hobbies?
- What are your favorite toys and which are the ones you don't like playing with?

**GAME**

**SINK OR FLOAT**

**What you need: Clear piece of tuber-ware/bowl and fill it with water**

Tell the kids we are playing Sink or Float. Make sure to position your camera so the kids can see your bowl of water. Tell them you have some items that you need their help in deciding if they will sink or float. Pick an item and show it on the camera. Ask the kids to yell: Sink or Float? And put it in the water.

**ITEMS THAT SINK**

- **metal utensils**
- **Coins**
- **Stones**
- **toy car/truck**
- **Keys**
- **Glass**
- **gemstones or marbles**

**ITEMS THAT FLOAT**

- **Duplo/Lego**
- **stick or popsicle stick**
- **corks**
- **bathtub toys**
- **foam shapes**
- **crayon**
- **rubber ball**



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**SUMMARY:** In **John 6:1-13** there were more than 5,000 men, women, and kids gathered on the hillside listening to Jesus. They listened to Jesus for such a long time, they started getting hungry. One of the disciples found a boy who had some loaves of bread and a few fish that he was willing to share, even though that was not nearly enough food for all of those people! Then, Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks to God, multiplied and passed the bread to those who were seated. Jesus did the same with the fish. This story is so important because it's a reminder that when we bring whatever we have to God, God can do so much more with it than we can even imagine.

### ELEMENTARY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **Why were there so many people around who needed to be fed?** Jesus was teaching and the people were there to hear Jesus.
- **What did the young boy have that he was willing to give?** Five loaves of bread and two fish.
- **What did Jesus do before the food was multiplied?** Jesus prayed and gave thanks.
- **What can we learn from this?** That God can use our gifts no matter how small we think they are! God gives us gifts to serve others to grow our faith in God!

### PRESCHOOL DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **How many people came to see Jesus?** Over 5000!
- **What did Jesus do on the hill?** He multiplied all the food that the boy gave.
- **Have you ever shared your food at lunch?** This boy shared his gift and God blessed it!
- **Who can you give a gift?** Your siblings or maybe your parents! God wants you to serve others by giving them a gift. Could be a hug or kiss!

**BIG IDEA: MY FAITH GROWS DEEPER WHEN I USE MY GIFTS.** When you share your gifts to serve others, whether it's helping someone learn to do something you already know how to do or even offering someone a hug. God can do even more with it than you can imagine.
