## September Clubhouse Games

### Week 1: Family Photo Game

#### Supplies:

10 or more family photos pennies and working up to the end and a larger amount of money.

#### Directions:

Arrange the photos in front of your kiddo. Call out the name of the family member and your kiddo should be able to identify them in the photo and point them out. You can also name the location and with for your kiddo to point out!

### Week 1: Scripture Head Shoulder Knees and Toes

Remember that song? Use the same hand movements but sing your verse instead. Anything involving movement is great! It becomes a game when you divide the kiddos into competing groups. After several practice rounds ask who can do it faster. Set a 30 second timer and see who can repeat the process the most times!



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### Week 2: The Listening Game

#### Supplies:

Several objects like toys, combs, salt shakers, spoon, etc.

**Directions:** Place the objects before the kiddo and let him/her observe. Now have your kiddo close his/her eyes. One by one, use individual objects to create a sound and have your kiddo guess what object it was.

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### Week 2: Scripture Snap It

Pick a verse. Try snapping your fingers in between phrases. Breaking a verse into phrases makes it easier to memorize. For example, “For God”...snap, snap...”so loved”...clap, clap...”the world”...snap snap.

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### Week 3: Follow the Leader

#### Supplies:

A list of simple activities and a space to play

#### Directions:

Select different themes for the game. It could be physical activity, gestures, or expressions. You can be the leader or give each kiddo a chance to be the leader. All the players will have to mimic what the leader does, jumping, dancing, laughing, etc.

### Week 3: Scripture Say the Verse Under Water

Read the verse out loud together then repeat it rubbing your fingers across your lips as you do. This makes your words sound like they are being spoken underwater. Kids go crazy for this. You could also read it in slow-mo, super fast and try



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### Week 4: Pitching Pennies!

#### Supplies:

Pennies or currency coins Large sized paper or plastic drinking cups

#### Directions:

Place the cup on a chair on the table in front of the kiddo. Give each kiddo 5 coins each. You can ask the kiddo to take a few steps away from the cup in accordance with his/her age. Explain to your kiddo that he/her has to toss the coins, one at a time, into the cup. The person with the most coins in the cup wins!

### Week 4: Scripture Scramble

Pick a verse and print it out on a piece of paper. Cut the words out of the verse and mix them up in a pile. Take turns putting the verse back together and see who can put it together the fastest!
