BLOCK PARTY - Week 2

SUMMARY: In week two, we return to **1 Samuel 20** for one of the most famous friendships in the entire Bible: David and Jonathan. These guys went through a lot together.

From making a promise to help each other to escaping the dangers of Jonathan's own father, King Saul, they showed us exactly what it meant for friends to love each other.

BOTTOM LINE: Friends love one another. Just like David and Jonathan, friends can show how they love each other by the way they care for one another and go above and beyond to help each other succeed. It's this sort of love we experience through Jesus. We pray that kids will follow Him and learn how they can help their friends know how much they're loved.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **Why do you like your friends?** Perhaps they treat you nicely, you have fun with them or they make you laugh!
- **Who were the main characters? What was today's story about?** The main character was David. Today's story was about Samuel and the friendship between David and Jonathan.
- **Why should friends love one another?** God loves us and cares for us. He asks us to do the same to others so we show the love of God to them.
- **What can we learn from this?** That we follow Him and learn how they can help their friends know how much they're loved.
