

Awesome! We're happy to support you however we can. Before you get to planning, here are just a few things you should know.

What kinds of events can I host?

Anything goes! Our mission at betahaus is to provide a space that fosters inspiration, motivation, courage, and know-how. We're a space defined by our community, and your imaginative ideas are what keep us going. We've had members plan game nights, documentary screenings, panel discussions, running clubs, creative workshops, photo shoots, Christmas parties, and more.

Where can I host an event?

Our buildings are both coworking and event spaces. While the spaces support each other, they also have different objectives. Before planning your event, it's important to understand the difference:

- **Our Coworking Spaces** include the Coworking Areas, Meeting Rooms, The Club Lounge and the Innospace. If you'd like to host an event, you should submit details to [this form](#) for the Coworking Team to review.
- **Our Event Spaces** include the Arena, the Bungalow, the Loft, the Workshop, the Hideout, and the Breakout. These spaces are managed by our Events Team and are usually booked for meetups, conferences, or other tech events. As these spaces aren't Coworking Spaces, we can't offer them for free, but discounts are available for Pro and Team Room Members. If you're hoping to hold an event in one of our event spaces, you can contact event@betahaus.de with your event details and budget, and they will send you a tailor-made offer.

Our house gets busy! To avoid disappointment, it is important that you reserve a location before planning or marketing your community event. We also ask that you observe the capacity of the rooms and limit event attendees accordingly.

Can betahaus help with my event?

We're crazy about events. In fact, we host around 1,000 startup events at betahaus each year! We'd like to get involved in all of them, but sometimes we just don't have the resources. Before submitting a request for a community event, here are a few things that you'll need to have an answer for:

- How many people will be attending?
- Are you making a profit, charging an entry fee, or selling something at this event?
- How will you close up the space if the event is after hours?
- Do you need extra resources (chairs, a projector, dishes, beer, etc.)?
- Are you able to clean up and reset the room to its original condition after your event?
- If the space hasn't been adequately cleaned, are you willing to pay the cleaning fee?
- Will you need staff members present?
- Are you requesting betahaus' support in any other ways?

We wish we could say yes to everything, but these are all factors we have to consider before approving your request for a Community Event. The more of them you have thought through when you present your event to us, the better the chances are for getting your event approved.

Please note: You're fully responsible for the production of your event from set up to and clean up unless otherwise agreed upon! Premium space, special equipment, catering, marketing support, or staff support are available as an add on, but additional charges may apply. See application form for more details.

How can I make my event into an official betahaus Community Event?

We have a few signature events at betahaus: betabreakfast, betabeer, Tupperware Tuesdays, and Office Hours.

From time to time, we are able to co-host events that offer significant value to the community IF AND ONLY IF we have the time to produce them. To be considered an official betahaus Community Event, your event must be **supported by betahaus staff** and **co-branded**.

Interested in hosting an official betahaus Community Event? Please indicate this in your [community event application](#). These events require time to produce, so please consider what you can offer in trade for our direct support (ie. consulting, design, free services, photography, etc.).

What about marketing?

We do our best to promote Community Events, but even we have our limits! Here are some of our ground rules for promoting events:

- You **can** use [our logo](#) and our location.
- You **can** share the event yourself in the [betahaus | Berlin Facebook group](#).
- You **can** ask us to share your event on betahaus Twitter or Facebook. Please email a photo and sample text to taylor@betahaus.de at least two weeks in advance. *Social sharing is subject to availability.*
- You **can** ask to have your event listed on the Events Calendar on our website.
- You **cannot** co-brand or represent your event as an official betahaus event unless it's been previously approved.
- For this reason, we also **cannot** co-host your event on Facebook.
- You **cannot** put up posters around the house without approval by the coworking team. You may put up a maximum of 5 posters per event. *Any posters distributed without permission will be removed.*

We hope that answers some of your questions about hosting an event at betahaus!
