Submission Criteria

Is the idea action-oriented, rather than research, convenings, policy development, or advocacy?	X
Does the idea focus on building and repairing unique bridges between people on the move and host communities, to promote meaningful engagement and sustainable, community-led change?	X





Design and Engagement Criteria

Does the idea reflect the context, cultures, knowledge, needs, and aspirations of those most impacted by the idea?	X
Does the idea go beyond meeting basic needs to help people fulfill their human needs of joy, hope, and dignity?	X
Does the idea move the world in a more equitable and just direction?	X
Does the idea recognize and incorporate the value of lived experience to solve a real problem for the community?	X
