During this project, learners will explore superheroes and everyday heroes, who help others in the community. They will reflect on what makes themselves special and how they can help others, before transforming themselves into superheroes! They will present their new identities at a 'Superhero Showcase'.

This project will support learners to master **Steps C** and **0** in **Speaking**, **Aiming High and Leadership**.



Introduction: Meet The Heroes

Learners explore the three focus skills and theme for this project.



Stage 1: From Zero to Hero

Learners apply Aiming High step 0 by identifying when things are difficult, as they explore superheroes and everyday heroes further.

Local Visit: Gathering Ideas

Learners explore how essential skills are used in the world of 'everyday heroes' by going on a local visit or virtual tour.



Stage 2: I've Got the Power

Learners apply Leadership step 0 by identifying and describing how they are feeling, as they explore their strengths and decide on a superhero name.



Stage 3: The Greatest Cape

Learners apply Speaking step 0 by speaking clearly to others, as they transform themselves into superheroes and demonstrate their strengths.



Stage 4: Time to Shine

Learners apply Speaking, Aiming High and Teamwork step 0 to make their final preparations for the 'Superhero Showcase'.

Exit Point: Superhero Showcase

Learners experience the excitement and challenges of a 'Superhero Showcase'.



Reflection: Superheroes Celebrate

Learners reflect on the successes of their 'Superhero Showcase' and on the skills used throughout the project.
