

**Heinz Memorial Chapel
University of Pittsburgh
Public Health Safety Measures**

In order to ensure the safety of visitors to the University's Heinz Memorial Chapel and to comply with applicable rules, regulations and guidance (including those from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Pennsylvania Department of Health, and the University of Pittsburgh), public health safety measures for weddings and events have been enacted at the Chapel until further notice. **Please note that these measures are subject to change.**

Masks: All event guests and vendors are required to wear masks that cover their mouth and nose while in the Chapel. Mask wearing is optional for the wedding couple, attendants and those being formally seated during active participation in the ceremony and rehearsal including the processional and recessional and during professional photography. Mask wearing is optional for readers, speakers, musicians and officiants during active participation in the ceremony and rehearsal and by maintaining six (6) feet of physical distance.

Guest Contact List: The wedding couple or main contact for the event is required to provide a list of names of all those attending and their vendors no later than seven (7) calendar days prior to the wedding or event date. The list must include a phone number or email address for each name for contact tracing purposes.

Capacity: Currently there is no limit on participant and guest capacity other than the Chapel's maximum capacity of 350 people.
