"Which direction should we go in?" Anna asked. Freda had an idea. "Let's look at the map!" So they looked at the map and set off towards the trees.




The explorers were walking for some time before they realised they were a bit lost. They used the binoculars to look around to see who could help them.



"Over there!" said a little mouse. He showed them a sign that pointed them in the direction of the lake. "Keep going that way" he said.




The explorers continued walking for some time before they realised they were lost again. They looked around to see who could help them.





"Over there!" hooted an owl. "Go back up the hill, then straight over the bridge."

They listened carefully and then followed the owl's instructions.










The explorers continued walking for some time, getting further and further from home. Suddenly, they realised they were lost again! They looked around to see who could help them.







Just then Freda thought of an idea. "Let's use our torch. It will help us find our way home." Jamie liked this idea. "Let's go back the way we came."












"Keep going that way!" hooted Owl. And so they knew they were on the right track.




The explorers continued on their way back home. "I can see something over there," said Anna. "Let's turn on our torch," said Jamie.
