NEW TELE-ICU SERVICE



SRMC's critically ill patients will soon benefit from the most advanced telemedicine program available in hospital intensive care units (ICUs) today. Early in May, SRMC will be partnering with Advanced ICU Care®, the nation's largest provider of tele-ICU services, to perform 24/7 monitoring by highly trained intensivist physicians and critical care specialists, providing an extra layer of care that enhances patient care and safety.

"Our ICU patients will receive the highest level of medical care available through the collaboration between their physician, SRMC's critical care team and the telemonitoring oversight of Advanced ICU Care," explained Dr. Anita Hackstedde, SRMC President/CEO.

Advanced ICU Care's team of intensivists and critical care nurses work from centralized operations centers and receive feeds of real-time patient data from an advanced monitoring system that is electronically connected to each ICU patient's room. The system continuously monitors an ICU patient's vital signs, labs and clinical status through in-room audio/video technology that can also be used for two-way communication between the patient's physician, the bedside critical care team and Advanced ICU Care; as they work in partnership to provide enhanced, life-saving tele-ICU services to SRMC patients.

SRMC's Imaging Center in Columbiana Launches New CT Scanner

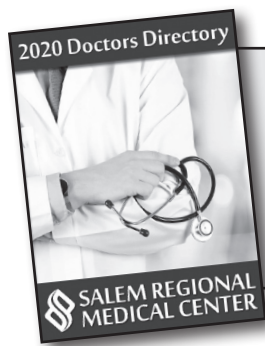
New CT technology is the latest addition to the advanced imaging services provided at our Imaging Center at Firestone Farms TownCenter in Columbiana, which offers 2D and 3D digital mammograms, DEXA bone density scans, ultrasounds and x-rays.

"With our advanced medical imaging technology, we can see what other imaging centers cannot see, leading to faster diagnosis and treatment," said Dr. Peter Apicella, Chair of SRMC's Department of Medical Imaging. "Columbiana area residents, who take advantage of this new CT scanning technology, will benefit from high-quality, faster imaging and up to a 40% reduction in radiation dose."
