## **SRMC Covid-19 Vaccine Clinic is Full**

(SALEM, OHIO) – January 15, 2021 – No more appointments are being accepted for Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC)'s Vaccine Clinic on Friday, January 22 between 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. The Vaccine Clinic's schedule is full and at maximum capacity, based on the supply of vaccines to be received next week from the Ohio Department of Health.

SRMC is to receive 100 doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine, to be given to seniors 80 years of age and older who already have appointments scheduled on January 22. No walk-in vaccinations will be administered at SRMC's Vaccine Clinic.

The vaccine has been prioritized for those 80 years and older, in accordance with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine's phased approach to immunize those at the highest risk of exposure to the coronavirus.
