SRMC Gives Over 100 Vaccines To Seniors

(SALEM, OHIO) – January 28, 2021 – Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC) administered over 100 Moderna COVID-19 vaccines to area seniors today. The vaccine was prioritized for those at the highest risk of serious illness and complications from the coronavirus, in accordance with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine’s phased immunization approach.

SRMC will host another community vaccine clinic on Thursday, February 4, but all appointments are filled. No walk-in vaccinations will be given.
