SRMC Covid-19 Vaccine Clinic is Full

(SALEM, OHIO) – February 3, 2021 – No more appointments are being accepted for Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC)′s Vaccine Clinic on Thursday, February 11 between 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. The Vaccine Clinic′s schedule is full and at maximum capacity, based on the supply of 100 vaccines expected to arrive next week from the Ohio Department of Health.

SRMC is to receive 100 doses of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, to be prioritized for seniors 65 years of age and older, or qualifying individuals under 65 with a specific medical condition AND developmental/intellectual disability; who already have appointments scheduled on February 11. No walk-in vaccinations will be given at SRMC′s Vaccine Clinic.

The vaccination timeline is in accordance with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine′s phased approach to immunize those at the highest risk of serious illness and complications from the coronavirus.
