SRMC Covid-19 Vaccine Clinic is Full

(SALEM, OHIO) – February 19, 2021 – No more appointments are being accepted for Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC)’s Vaccine Clinic on Friday, February 26 between 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. The Vaccine Clinic’s schedule is full and at maximum capacity, based on the supply of 100 vaccines to arrive from the Ohio Department of Health. No walk-in vaccinations will be given at SRMC’s Vaccine Clinic.

SRMC is to receive 100 doses of the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, which is prioritized for seniors 65 years of age and older, and those under 65 with specific, early onset childhood conditions that are carried into adulthood, as defined by the Ohio Department of Health. The vaccines have been prioritized for these groups in accordance with Ohio Governor Mike DeWine’s phased approach to immunize those at the highest risk of exposure to the coronavirus.
