SRMC's Behavioral Medicine & Wellness Center Launches New Aftercare Program

(SALEM, OHIO) – February 24, 2021 – Salem Regional Medical Center's (SRMC) Behavioral Medicine and Wellness Center (BMWC) is launching a new Aftercare Program to provide its clients with additional support following completion of their initial mental health treatment.

According to Jamie Benner, BMWC Program Manager, the 8-week Aftercare Program is open to those who have successfully completed the BMWC's Partial Hospitalization and/or Intensive Outpatient Treatment Program.



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“The Aftercare Program gives participants the opportunity to continue to work on their treatment goals as they transition back into their daily lives after receiving intensive outpatient care at the BMWC,” she said. “Aftercare sessions focus on strengthening the skills learned during the initial treatment phase to further support our clients in their ongoing recovery.”

Aftercare groups will be held at the BMWC on Mondays from 1 – 3:30 p.m. The cost of the program will be billed to participants' insurance.

SRMC's Behavioral Medicine and Wellness Center offers intensive outpatient programs for adults facing a range of mental health conditions, including depression; anxiety; mood changes; and grief, loss and trauma. The outpatient programs are facilitated by psychiatrist Sharon DiLauro, M.D., and a team of specially-trained therapists.
