SRMC Offers Covid-19 Vaccines on March 5

(SALEM, OHIO) – March 3, 2021 – Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC) will receive 200 Johnson & Johnson Covid-19 vaccines for its vaccine clinic to be held on March 5 from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. The vaccines will be administered to individuals age 60 and over, and those under 60 with specific medical conditions as defined by the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), such as type 1 diabetes. Also included in the list of newly eligible vaccine recipients are those working in child care services, funeral services and law enforcement and corrections officers.

How To Register: Those who are 60 and over or who are under 60 and meet ODH's eligibility requirements should call SRMC's Covid-19 vaccine registration line at 330-332-7511 on weekdays between 7:30 a.m.-4:30 p.m., or until appointments are filled. In order to be eligible to receive an appointment, callers must provide their name, phone number and birthdate. If the person is under 60, they must also provide their specific qualifying medical condition or occupation, as defined by ODH. (A list of ODH's qualifying conditions and occupations can be found at <https://coronavirus.ohio.gov/static/vaccine/phase-1c-fact-sheet.pdf>.) All vaccine recipients must be age 18 and older.

Once the 200 Johnson & Johnson vaccine appointments are filled, no more requests will be accepted for the vaccine clinic on March 5, and no walk-in vaccinations will be given. The Johnson & Johnson vaccine is a single-dose vaccine. Note: There is no charge to receive this Covid-19 vaccination.

Where To Go: SRMC's Vaccine Clinic will be located on the ground floor of the Hospital, which is located at 1995 East State Street in Salem. Those with scheduled appointments should enter the campus from East Pershing Street and park in the Surgery Center lot. Participants should then enter the building through the Surgery Center entrance and will be asked to provide a government-issued ID upon arrival.

SRMC is a member of Columbiana County's Vaccine Taskforce, which provides several locations where eligible community members can receive their vaccine.
