**Orthopaedic Surgeon Dr. Jason Boyd to Present  
Free Seminar On Common Shoulder Problems**

(SALEM, OH)—April 12, 2021---Area residents suffering from shoulder pain are invited to attend a free community seminar presented by fellowship-trained orthopaedic surgeon Jason Boyd, M.D., on Monday evening, April 26.

The educational program, "Common Shoulder Problems," will be held at Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC) in the Tower Conference Room, located on the ground floor.

Doors to the event will open at 6 p.m. so that attendees can view educational displays, followed by Dr. Boyd's presentation at 6:30 p.m. Dr. Boyd will discuss common causes of shoulder pain and the range of treatment options available, from arthroscopic procedures to total joint replacement.
