Dr. Camp will present “Preventing Skin Cancer” on Tuesday, May 11. The program will be held at SRMC in the Tower Conference Room, located on the ground floor.

Doors to the event will open at 6 p.m. so that attendees can view educational displays, followed by Dr. Camp’s presentation at 6:30 p.m. Dr. Camp will discuss how to protect your skin from the sun, types of skin cancer, and when to see your doctor about skin changes.
