## **SRMC Cancer Support Group To Meet Sept. 8**

(SALEM, OHIO) – August 31, 2021— Community members facing the challenges of a cancer journey can gain encouragement and understanding of this disease during a free support group hosted by University Hospitals Seidman Cancer Center at Salem Regional Medical Center (SRMC).

The group's next monthly meeting will be held from 3-4 p.m., Wednesday, September 8 in SRMC's Oncology Conference Room, located on the hospital's second floor, past the Cancer & Infusion Center on the left-hand side.

SRMC's Cancer Support Group is open to anyone in the community in cancer treatment and cancer survivors. Sessions are led by SRMC's licensed oncology social worker, and offer education and emotional support for people with any type of cancer.

The group meets one Wednesday a month.
