Medication Drop-off Program in
Columbiana County on October 23, 2021

(COLUMBIANA COUNTY, OH) October 8, 2021-- On Saturday, October 23rd, the National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day, sponsored by the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), will be held in communities across America, including Columbiana County, to raise awareness about the dangers of prescription drug abuse.

Locally, area residents will have an opportunity to drop off their unused, unwanted or expired medications on Saturday, October 23rd from 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m., at two locations in East Liverpool and Salem, as follows:

How to Participate

- Area residents will remain in their cars and hand off the unwanted medications to local law enforcement officers, who will be the only staff handling the medications. No requests for identification will be asked.
- Unwanted capsules or tablets may be kept in their original containers or removed from the original container.
- If an original container is disposed, please try to remove any personal identifying information from the prescription label.

This one-day medication collection effort is being sponsored by the ADAPT of Columbiana County (330-424-0531), Columbiana County Drug Task Force (330-424-0309) and local law enforcement jurisdictions, Col. Cty. Health Dept. (330- 424-0272), Col. Cty. Mental Health & Recovery Services Board (330-424-0195), E. Liverpool City Health Dept. (330-385-7900), Family Recovery Center (330-424-1468), E. Liverpool City Hospital (330-385-7200), Salem City Health Dept. (330-332-1618), Salem Regional Medical Center (330-332-7152), and Heritage Thermal. These organizations are collaborating on this county-wide event to remove potentially dangerous controlled substances from people’s homes.
