BEAM RAISING FOR SRMC SURGERY & OUTPATIENT PAVILION



Progress continues for the SRMC Surgery & Outpatient Pavilion at Firestone Farms TownCenter in Columbiana as the final beam was raised on October 13, 2022. This event celebrated an important milestone in the construction of the state-of-the-art facility that is scheduled for completion in 2023.

"We're excited to see this new facility come to life as we continue to build upon our legacy of delivering world-class care that will directly impact the overall health of our communities," said Anita Hackstedde, M.D., SRMC President/CEO. "The new facility will feature an outpatient surgery and endoscopy center, advanced medical imaging, infusion therapy services and specialty physician offices."

According to Dr. Hackstedde, SRMC's Surgery & Outpatient Pavilion is part of SRMC's strategic plan to provide more convenient access to advanced outpatient procedures and treatments at a lower cost than traditional hospital-based services. A team of experienced healthcare design and construction firms is leading the project, with Wilmot Sanz serving as the Project Architect and Shook Construction engaged as the Construction Manager.
