Summary

Webflow would like to keep customizations at the minimum, but sometimes they are necessary.

Thre is a 10000 characters limit for the custom ebedded code.

I will describe a workaround to this limitation.

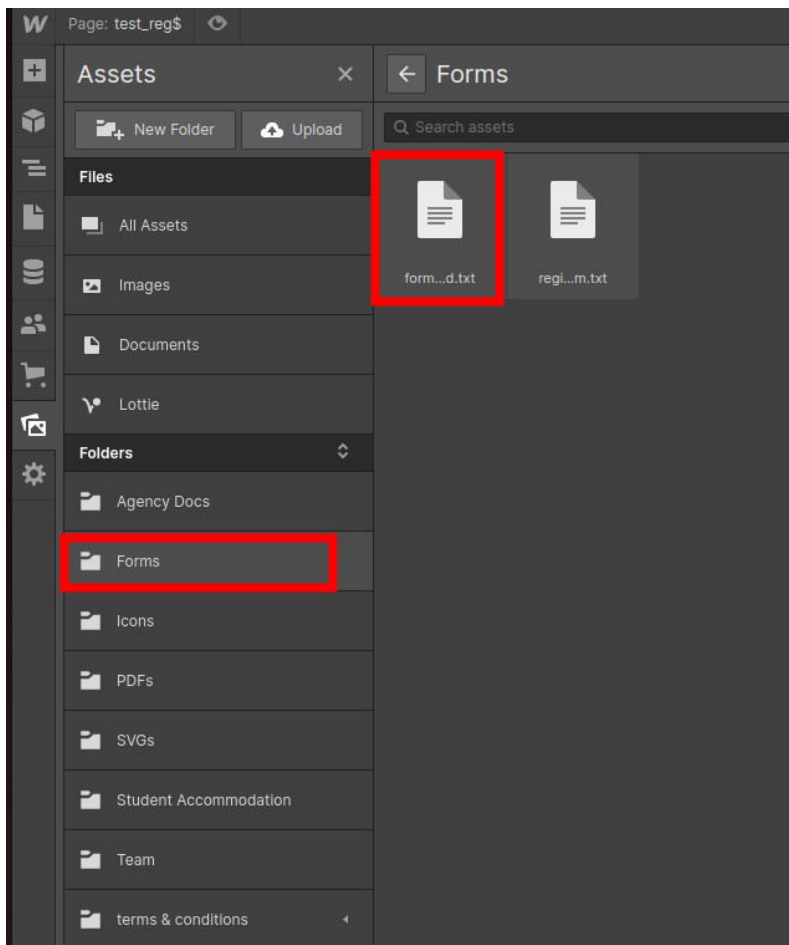
Steps

Upload a file

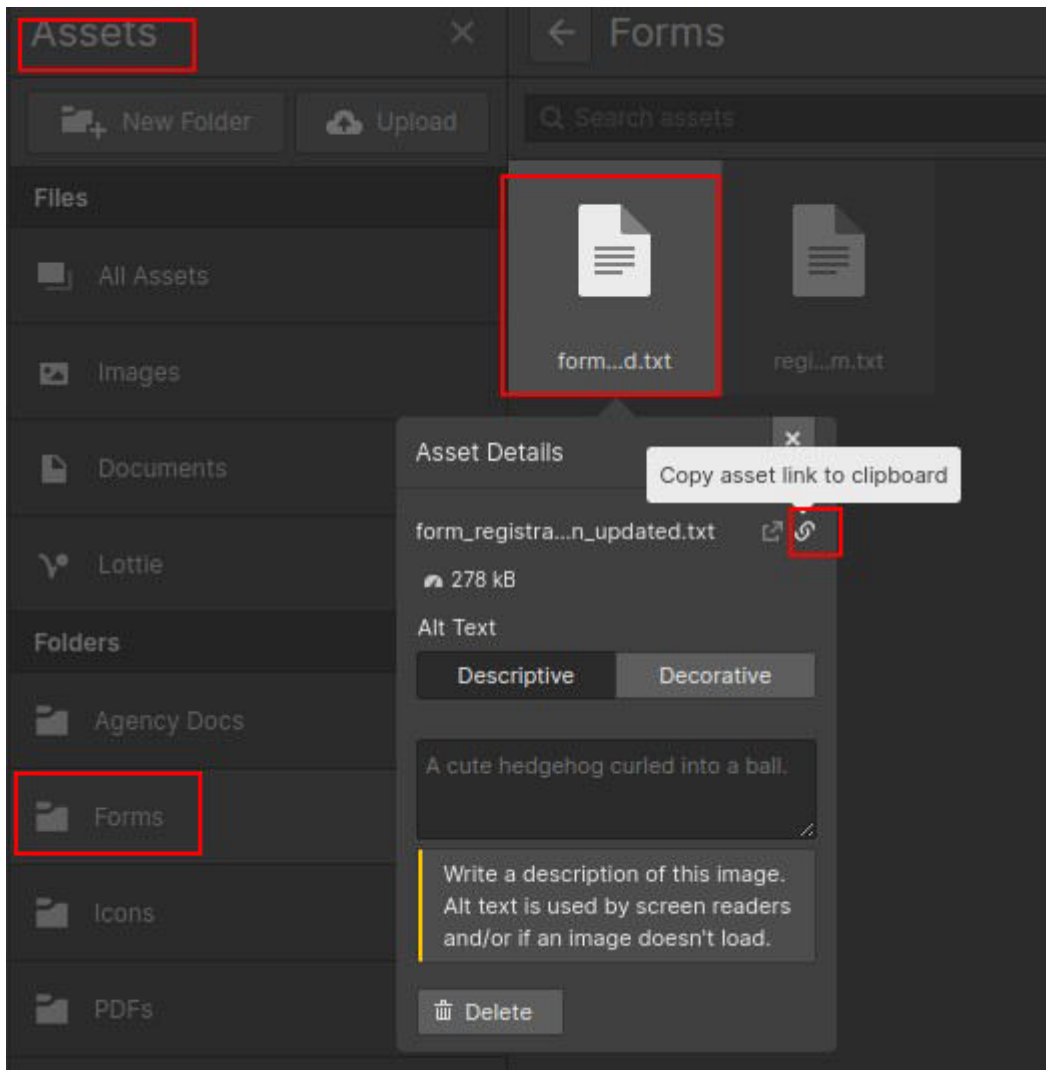
Save the file using the *.txt format, because webflow doesn't allow the user to upload an *.htm file.

Upload the file to the desired location.

For this example, I have uploaded the file “form_registration_updated.txt” to the forms folder



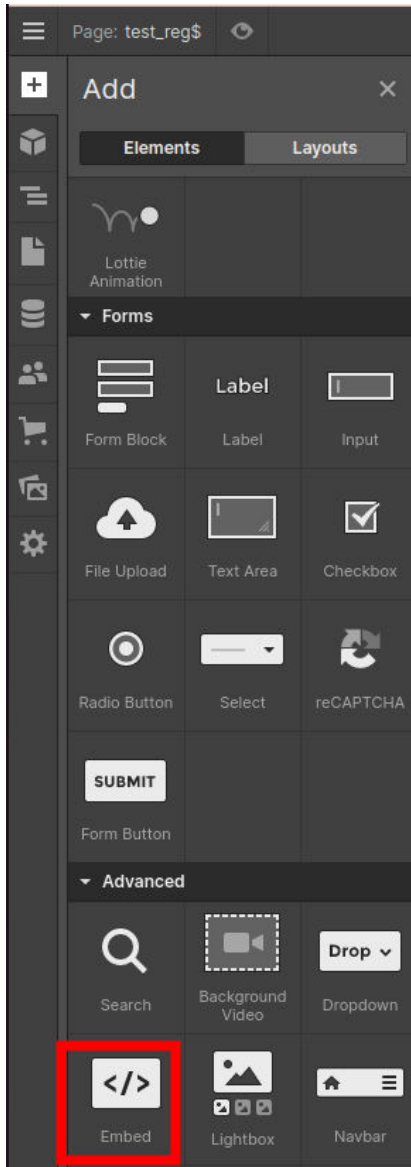
Get the file url and save it for later

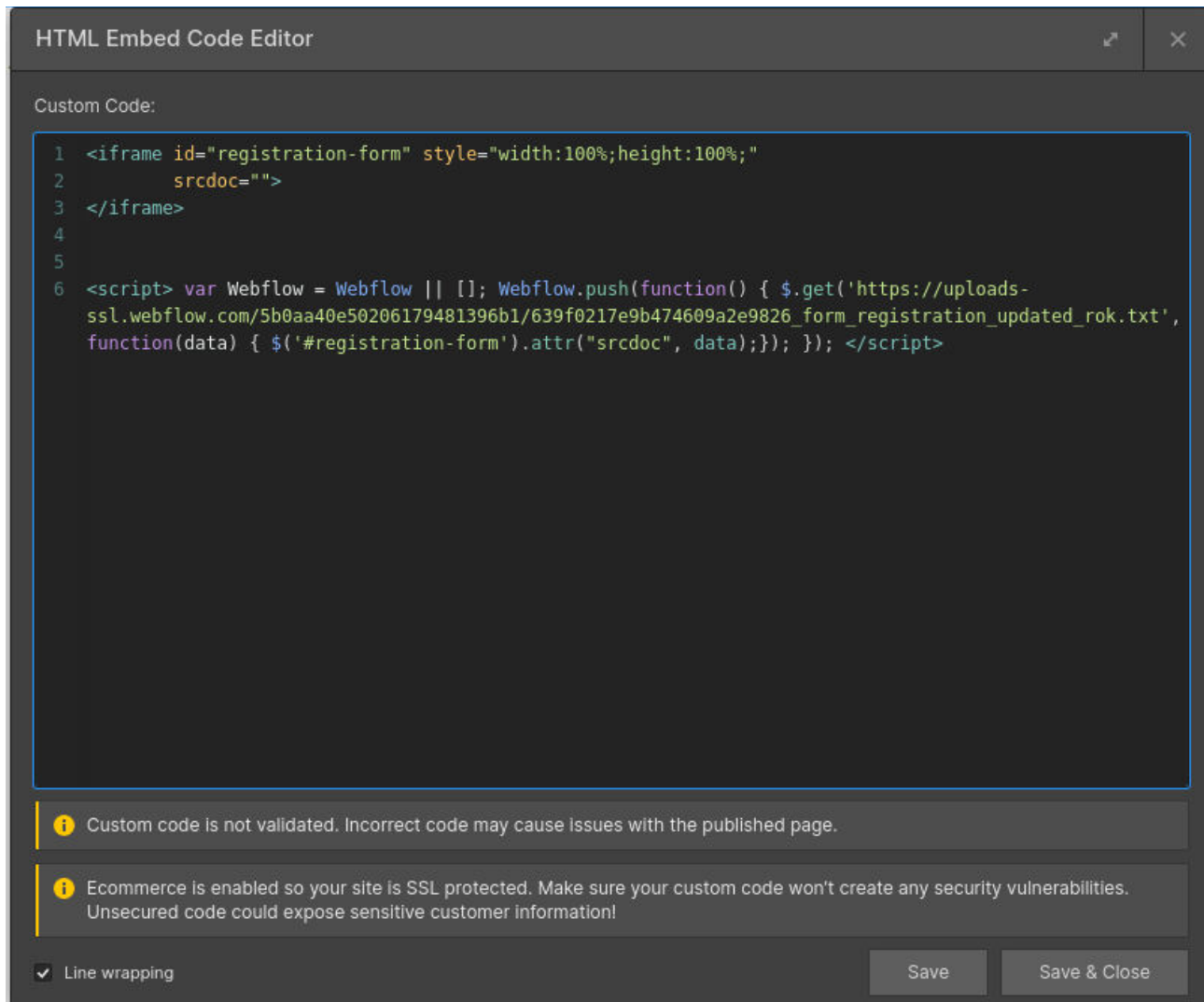
Add embed element to page



Edit the size of the element.

Edit embed code

Double click on the embed element and add the code that reads the data from the uploaded file



Code:

Customize the code

- You can customize the iframe element name. Be sure to change the name on both occurrences
- You can use another another file, and past the other file url. You can get the url in the “Get the file url and save it for later” step.

In case you need additional styling around the iframe, in case you can't do that with webflow, you can use this code instead and fiddle with the styles, width, height etc

Changes that had to be made to the form HTML

Because iframe is a HTML element that loads another HTML page within the document, the redirect has to be made to outside the iframe.

So in the form html file, change:

```
window.location.replace("https://www.speak.ae/thanks/registration");

to

window.parent.location = "https://www.speak.ae/thanks/registration";
```
