

# Kananook Creek Retaining Wall Renewal

## Description

These works were necessary to repair the wall to provide stability for the creek bank and to protect surrounding assets, including the pathway, road and drainage network. The retaining wall works were carried out between Wells Street and Beach Street, Frankston. The Joint Venture (JV) delivered an upgraded retaining wall for the people and community living in the Frankston City Council catchment area. Comacon provided stakeholder engagement, community relations and communications for the project.



## Approach

Our consultant worked as the Communications and Engagement Lead, during the design and construction phases of the project within the overall program of works managing community and stakeholder engagement through extensive consultation with local neighbours and community groups.

## Highlights

This was a difficult project, in that there were three other invasive construction programs occurring at the same time and residents on Long Island were struggling with construction fatigue. Our consultant built strong relationships with local residents early on in the project through extensive consultation and prompt responses to ensure issue resolution was quick and thorough.
