

While some COVID restrictions have been lifted, the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center Dallas (KBHCCD) is dedicated to upholding the highest cleaning procedures to ensure the safety and health of our visitors and staff.

We remain vigilant in actively monitoring and applying the industry's best practices and follow the cleaning guidelines recommended by the CDC, state and local health agencies. In addition, we have exceeded expectations by following protocols required by the GBAC STAR™ accreditation.

Our team at the KBHCCD continues to apply our expanded cleaning protocols, which are highlighted below.

- Hand sanitizer stands are placed at all entrances, escalators, and high frequent touch points to encourage attendees to use as they enter and leave the facility.
- We have disinfecting wipes in front of all furniture, ATMs, and elevators.
- All escalator handrails pass through a UV light that disinfects them on each pass through.
- Air purifying fans were installed in our elevators to help keep the air fresh and clean.
- All elevators had a self-sanitizing button placed on each button.
- We upgraded our filters to Merv 13 to help collect finer particles and they are changed each quarter.
- We disinfect each space prior to each event and each event night. We also use backpack sprayers to disinfect large areas ensuring that nothing is missed.
- After we clean all areas of the facility, we use ATP strips to measure the amount of live bacteria, and viruses on each surface to ensure that there is no trace amount left behind.

Under the guidance of GBAC, a Division of ISSA, the worldwide cleaning industry association, the KBHCCD has implemented the most stringent protocols for cleaning, disinfection and infectious disease prevention in its facility. They continue to enhance what they have learned throughout the various stages of the pandemic.
