Cost of Student Camp

The cost of this years camp is 220.00 **(there is a 10.00 service fee for credit card)** and includes a backpack, water bottle, food, snacks, lodging and all games and supplies. Your student will not need any money during the week.

Cost Does Not Include

Breakfast Monday morning, Supplies (i.e. notebook, pens, paper), Bible, linens, pillows, sleeping bag, toiletries.

Payment Options

Check and Credit card only. Unfortunately we cannot accept cash, debit or moneyorders.

If a family has more than one child, you will still need to register each individually as in years past. Each student in that family will have separate credit card transactions and separate checks.

Drop Off: There is no transportation to Lion King.

You will drop your student off on Monday July 8, between 9:45-10:30 am sharp at the Retreat Kitchen. Please park in the designated area and walk to the check in table where you will sign in your youth and turn in to our nurse any medication your student will need for the week. There is no breakfast provided that morning.

Pick Up: There is no transportation from Lion King.

You will pick up your student on Saturday July 13 between 10 and 10:30 am at the same place (Retreat Kitchen) you dropped your student off. Please park in the designated area and walk to the sign out table where you will sign out your student and receive any medication you gave our nurse during the **Drop Off** procedure. The Youth will eat breakfast but there is no lunch provided that day.

2019 Remnant Retreat Policies

Student Retreat Dating Policy

- Students ***are not allowed to begin any new dating relationships during retreat.***
- If a student is in a relationship prior to the start of retreat, and both parties of the dating relationship are registered for retreat, they are not permitted to sit by each other anytime during retreat, and ***any public display of affection is grounds for dismissal from camp.***
- Guys and girls are not allowed in each others campsites or cabins.

Dress Code

- Students may wear knee length shorts. **Students who bring excessively short shorts will not be allowed to wear them.** You may also wear Capri pants, khakis or jeans. **Girls may wear shorts above knee length, but leggings or sliders must be worn underneath them.**
- For water activities, swimsuits are acceptable. However, **they must be covered by a dark t-shirt and shorts that will not be able to be seen through when wet.** Leggings or sliders may be removed for swimming times only as guys and girls will be separated during these times. This policy is for all students including both males and females. Guys and girls have separate swimming times.

Technology Policy

- Students are allowed to bring a cell phone to camp for the sole purpose of **calling their parent or guardian at the designated times.** Cell phones will be collected when the parent signs in their student on Monday. The student can access their cell phone **in the afternoons that the students have a rest period** (which may not be everyday). Students will receive their phones for 15 mins and then turn them back in to their small group leader. Students are not allowed to play or watch someone play video games on their phone or any other device during retreat.

- No ipads, ipods, music devices, mp3 players, video games or headphones of any type are allowed at camp.
- Students will be allowed to use their small group leaders phone if they need to check in with a parent or guardian at any time during the week. Many areas on the retreat facility do not have cell service.
- Any student found with inappropriate media/data on their phone or found violating any of the policies listed here will be asked to leave camp.
- Any student that does not turn in a phone, or is found with a device or on a device outside of designated times without permission will have to contact their parents and let them know they will not get their device back until the end of the trip. That student may also be asked to leave camp.

Behavior Policy

- Students are expected to be respectful, obedient and submissive to all authority at all times. Students will be asked to leave camp if their behavior is severe enough to warrant dismissal or requires repeated correction.
- No profane, crude or disrespectful language will be tolerated. Students will be asked to leave the retreat facility if they participate in this behavior.
