- Manifesting of Ontario LTL freight from CCT o Ensure receipt of daily release email from CCT on unit readiness, and scanned manifest.
- Ensure timely completion of CCT's trip and manifest and advise Ontario Dispatch upon completion.
- Ensure that all BOL's scanned by CCT are tracked in Truckmate and Armours freight bill number added to the trip for cross refencing
- Ensure timely communication with CCT shift clerk on any concerns, TDG issues, or missing information.
- Monitoring and reporting on all priority freight movements inbound and outbound
- Documenting and tracking of Interliner "freight no bills" and "split" shipments for trends and analysis
- Scanning and indexing of Interliner manifests with OS&D notations
- Auditing and documentation of load quality, ensuring pictures are downloaded and indexed to gain operational efficiencies
