



Road Closure/Delay Notice June 15, 2019

To Whom It May Concern:

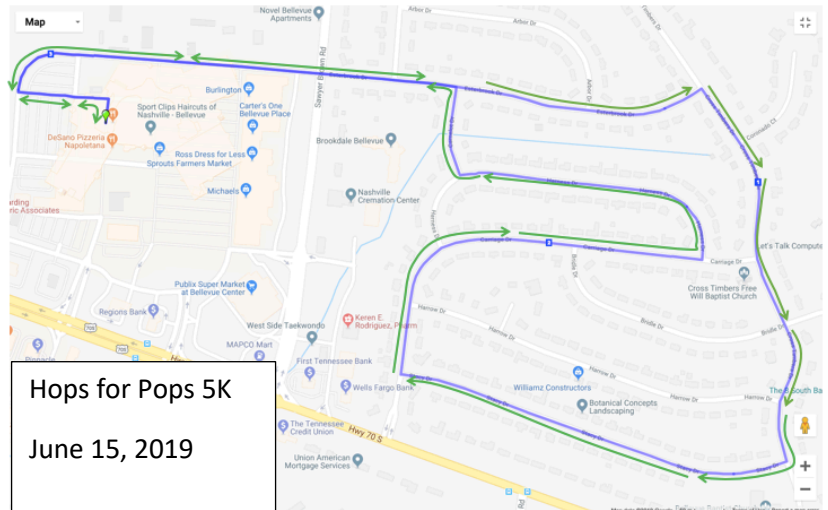
This letter serves as a courtesy notice to inform you that the Hops for Pops 5K run/walk will be held on **Saturday, June 15, 2019** starting at 8:00 AM and finishing at approximately 9:30 AM. It will start and finish at One Bellevue Place shopping center.

In an effort to minimize the event's impact on your business or residence, we are taking this opportunity to inform you about road delays related to the race. Please see the attached map for affected roads. We are allowing for traffic flow out of the neighborhood utilizing one lane for traffic flow and one designated for runners. If you need access across any of these streets during the event, there will be police officers, volunteers and cyclists along the route to guide you. Officers will do their best to work traffic across affected roads when there are breaks in the line of walkers / runners. We ask all drivers to proceed with caution.

These following roads will be impacted with delays at approximately 8:00 AM. All of these roads will re-open, completely, by 9:30 AM or earlier:

- Starting at One Bellevue place running around The back of the movie theater
- Crossing over Sawyer Brown Rd
- Continue on Esterbrook Drive turning right
- Onto Cross Timbers Drive turning right
- To Stacy Drive turning right
- Onto Carriage Drive curving to the right to turn left
- Onto Harness Drive and right
- Onto Camelot Drive to turn left
- Onto Esterbrook Drive returning to Start/Finish line

Clean-up of the route will take place following the Last walker/runner which should clear out of neighborhood by 9:00am
