We need a person who can help us experience and articulate who Christ is, and not just recite teachings about Christ and the Church and proclaim abstract moral principles... but to live the faith and make members' involvement in the parish the well spring of God's merciful justice and love. That will take more than just another "cleric" whose role is obscured by centuries of institutional overlays. 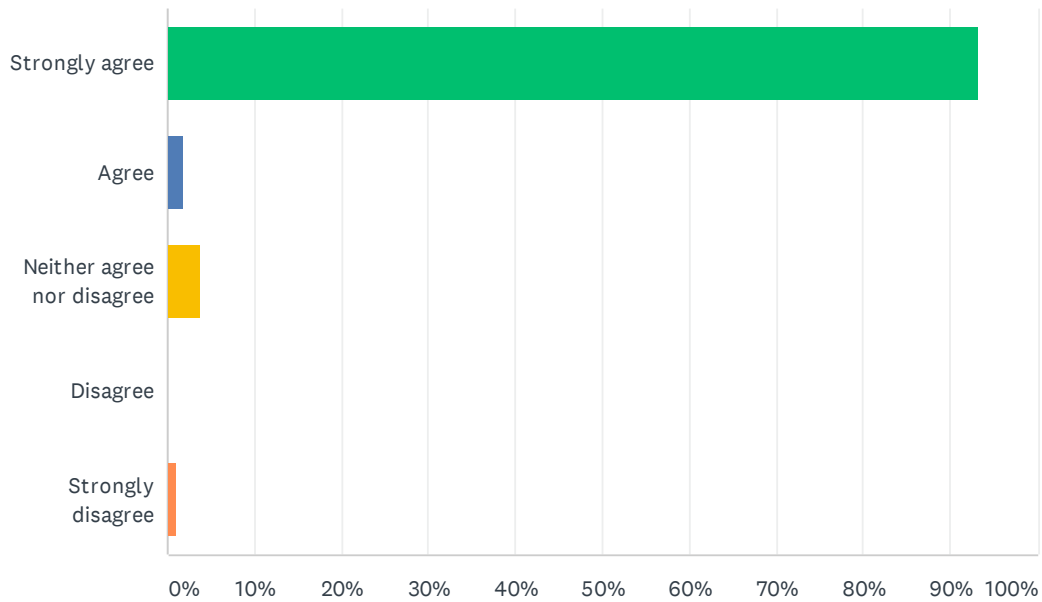

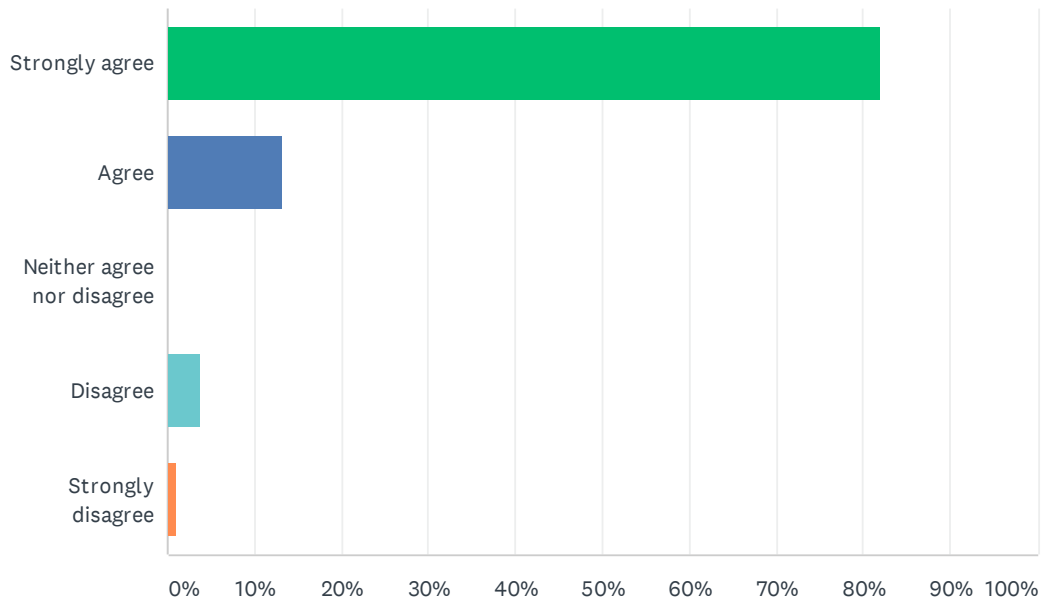

# Q4 The next bishop of Cleveland should be inclusive of LGBTQ Catholics and families.

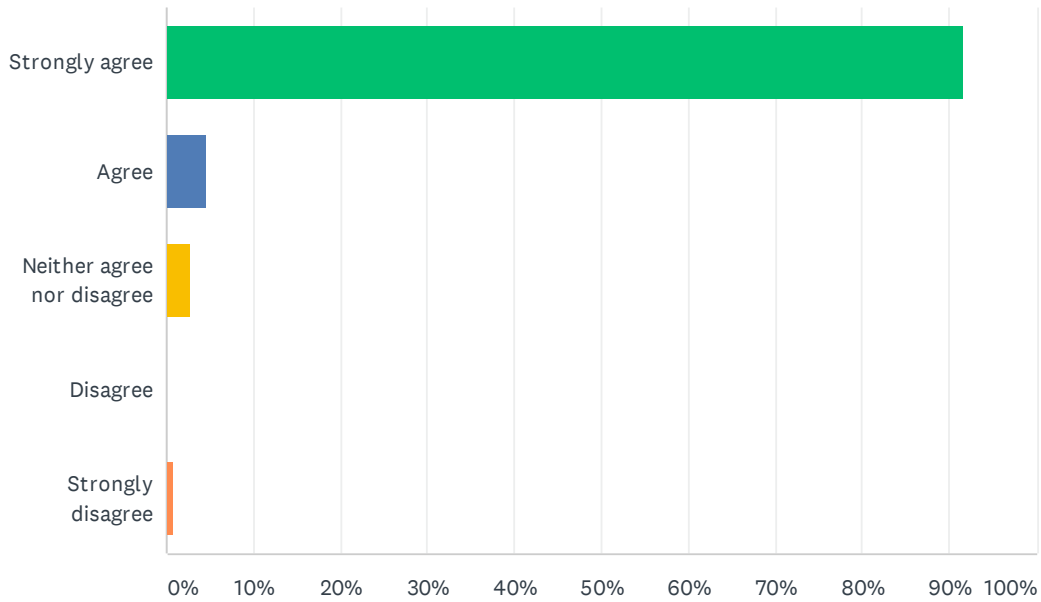

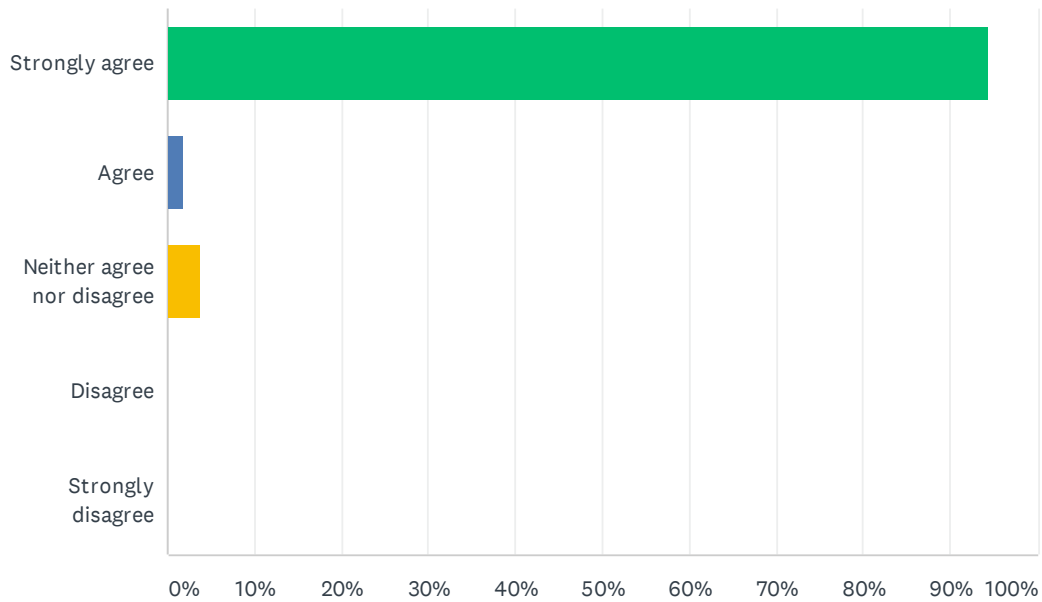

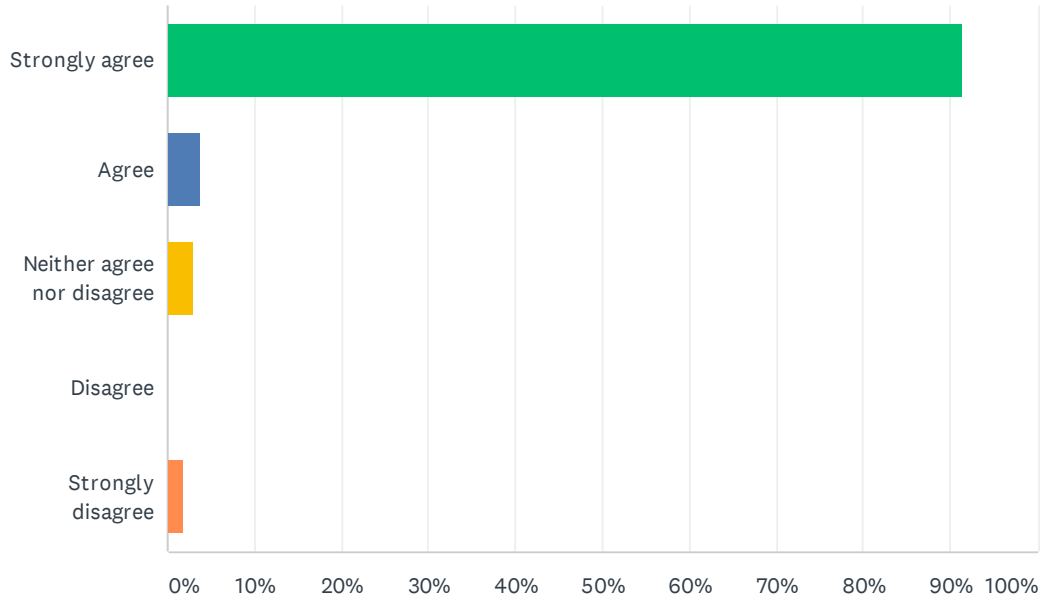

## Q7 The next bishop of Cleveland should be supportive of efforts to expand social justice.

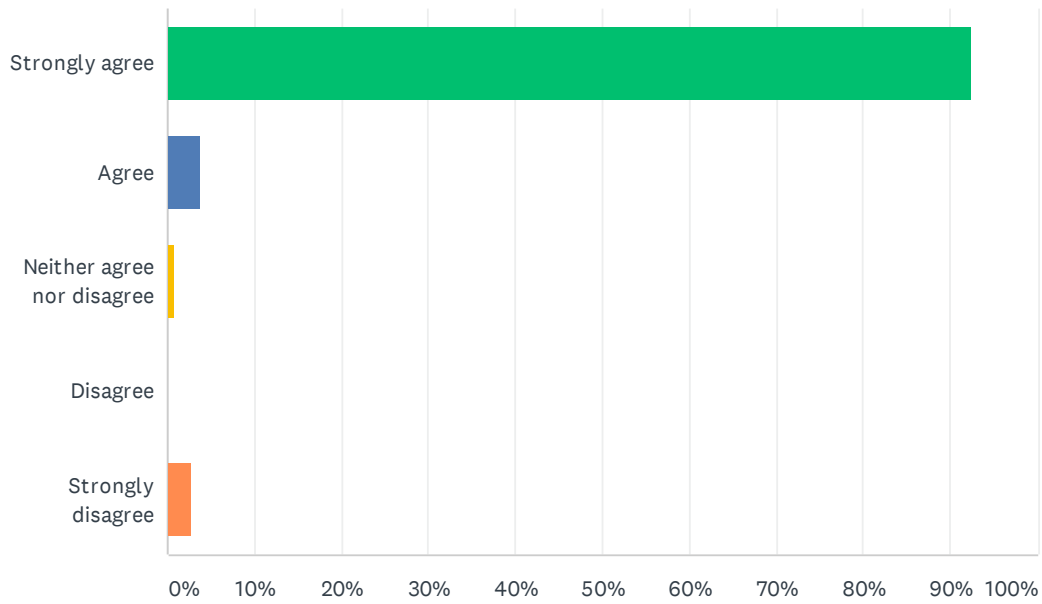

## Q8 The next bishop of Cleveland should support lay leadership in the diocese.

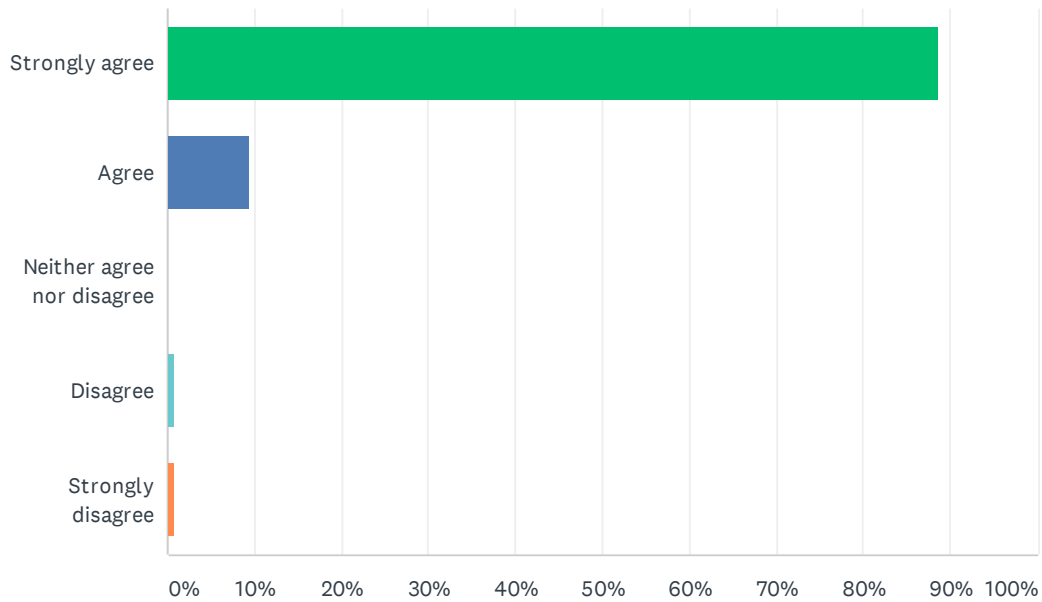

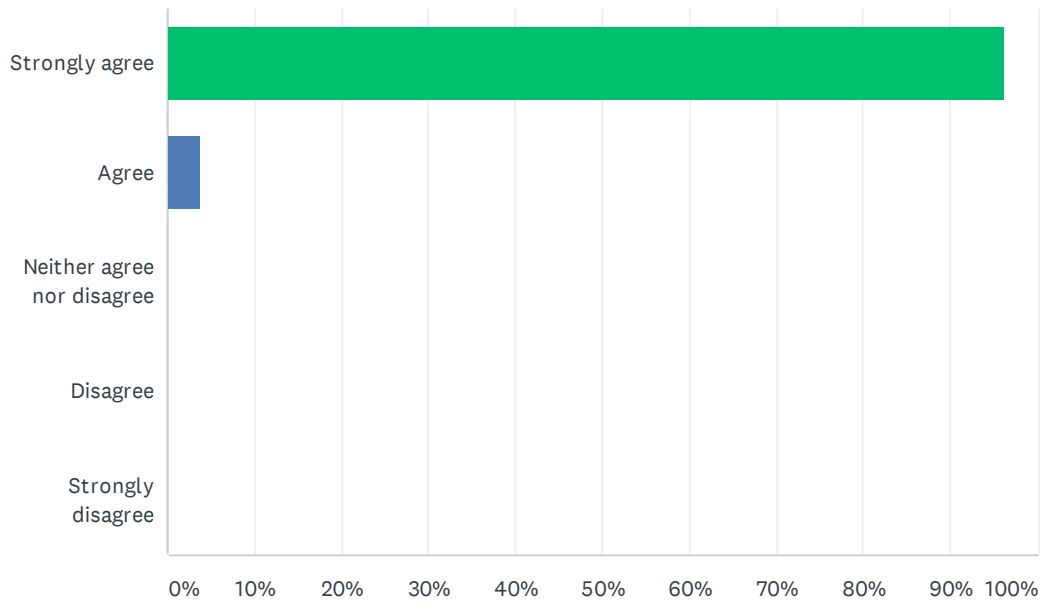

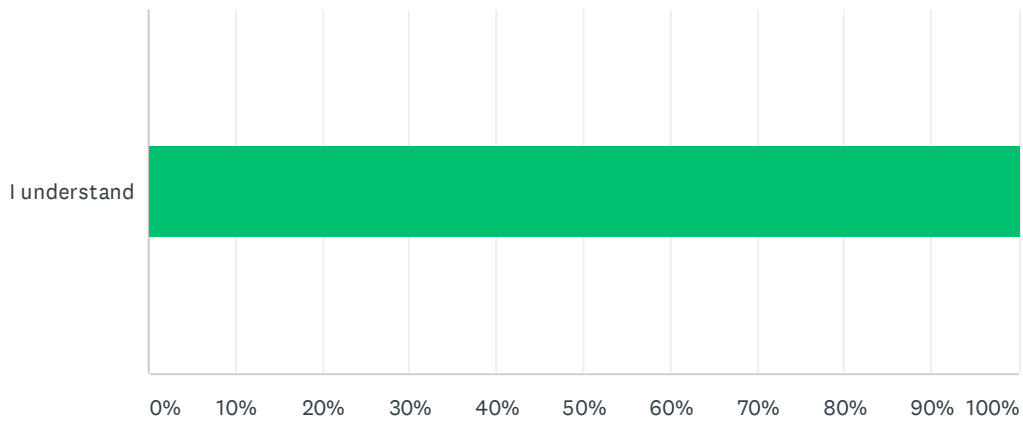
