Position Title: RKidz Early Childhood Coordinator

Primary Purpose

To lead an environment where children (ages birth through kindergarten) and their families feel welcomed, loved and connected. The Early Childhood Coordinator will schedule, recruit, and train leaders within their environment, set up materials as needed and collaborate with the RKidz Team.

Position Requirements

- College degree preferred, or one to three year's related experience.
- Experience leading people and working with children.
- Ability to engage with children in a developmentally appropriate manner.
- Strong desire and ability to love and lead volunteers.
- Ability to foster an environment of creativity and excitement.
- Basic Computer skills.
- Knowledge of Pro Presenter, CCB (Church Community Builder), and Mac preferred, but not required.
- Professional presence on the phone and in-person.
- Ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing.
- Ability to work independently, as well as with a team.
- Coachable and receives direction well.

Position Responsibilities

- Recruit, train, schedule, and foster relationships with volunteer leaders.
- Weekly room set up including uploading monthly videos and clean up.
- Create welcoming and age-appropriate environments for children ages babies through kindergarten.
- Cast vision for the NexGen mission and align events, volunteers, and families to suit.
- Empower leaders to have ownership and promote engagement within the ministry.
- Create a fun and team driven environment in which leaders love to serve.
- Prep for leaders and be hospitable and encouraging to them as they serve.

- Collaborate with the RKidz Curriculum Coordinator as needed about Orange curriculum.
- Communicate positively with families and/or parents directly regarding issues or accidents.
- Maintain supplies and classrooms in a neat and orderly fashion.
- Attend necessary team meetings including RKidz, All Staff, NextGen, and Prep & Pray.
