Welcome

A big welcome from the West Harbour rugby community to St Lukes Park Concord for the Under 15s State Championships! We hope your visit to St Lukes Park is an enjoyable one.

COVID

All players, officials and spectators are required to register their attendance by scanning the attached Service NSW QR code.

Parking

Ample parking can be found at the following locations (all in close proximity to playing fields). Parking is marked with a **P** on the maps below.

Some parking Venues will attract a gold coin donation to park.

- i) P1 — a sizeable car park on Crane Street, adjacent to St Lukes North field
- ii) P2 — on Crane Street adjacent to St Lukes North
- iii) P3 — on Gipps Street, adjacent to Concord Oval, corner Gipps Street and Loftus Rd
- iv) P4 — Concord Community Centre off Gipps Street
- v) P5 — on Stanley Street, opposite Concord High School –
but **DO NOT PARK INSIDE THE SCHOOL, AS YOU WILL BE LOCKED IN!!**

Nearest shopping precincts

- **Concord West**, Majors Bay Road (Supermarket plus pharmacies),
- **Five Dock**, Great North Road (Supermarket plus pharmacies);
- **Burwood**, Burwood Road (lots of shops — but parking is almost impossible!)

Transport

- **Train** —nearest station Burwood (10 minutes' walk)
- **Bus** — 461 to city on Parramatta Road

Coffee, Canteen and BBQ

A canteen and BBQ will operate adjacent to St Lukes 1. A coffee and ice cream cart will also be present for the weekend. No team or individual BBQs are allowed (Council edict).



Code of Conduct

All team officials, players, parents and spectators must adhere to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct. Additionally, there is a Zero tolerance of match official abuse: anyone who breaches this code of conduct will be ejected from the championships and grounds.

Alcohol

No alcohol is to be brought onto any ground, or consumed during the tournament.

Warm Up Facilities

These are indicated on the attached map

- St Lukes Oval
- St Lukes soccer field

Amenity blocks

Toilets are indicated on the map. There are very limited change room facilities.

Marquees

Marquees can be placed adjacent to St Lukes 1 and 2 on Crane Street, or on the Gipps side of St Lukes 2. Please keep the marquees well back from the playing area, including dead ball lines — at least 8 metres.

Ground Marshalls

A Ground Marshall will be assigned to each field, and will be responsible for

- the smooth running of games;
- ensuring all players and officials remain in the designated zones;
- ensuring that the behaviour of players, officials and spectators conforms to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct, and that inappropriate behaviour is reported to NSWRU.

Sign on

The sign on area will be located under the awning of the Hockey facilities — see map.

Rubbish

Garbage bins will be provided around each ground. However, please bring strong rubbish bags with you, and ensure that your team area is cleaned each day.

First Aid at the Ground:

Medical emergencies at the ground over the weekend will be looked after by a qualified First Aid Officer, who will be situated under a medical marquee. If there is an injury on field, please alert the First Aid Officer.



The First Aider will have ice on hand to be applied where appropriate for the treatment of injuries after the player has been assessed. Any player requiring ice must be seen by the First Aid Officer — ice will not be handed out.

Concussion: In the event of a player receiving a head or neck injury, or if any player is suspected of being concussed, the player must be referred to the First Aid officer.

Ambulances: Under no circumstances should any person on site call an ambulance. The First Aid Officer will triage events, and call an ambulance if required.

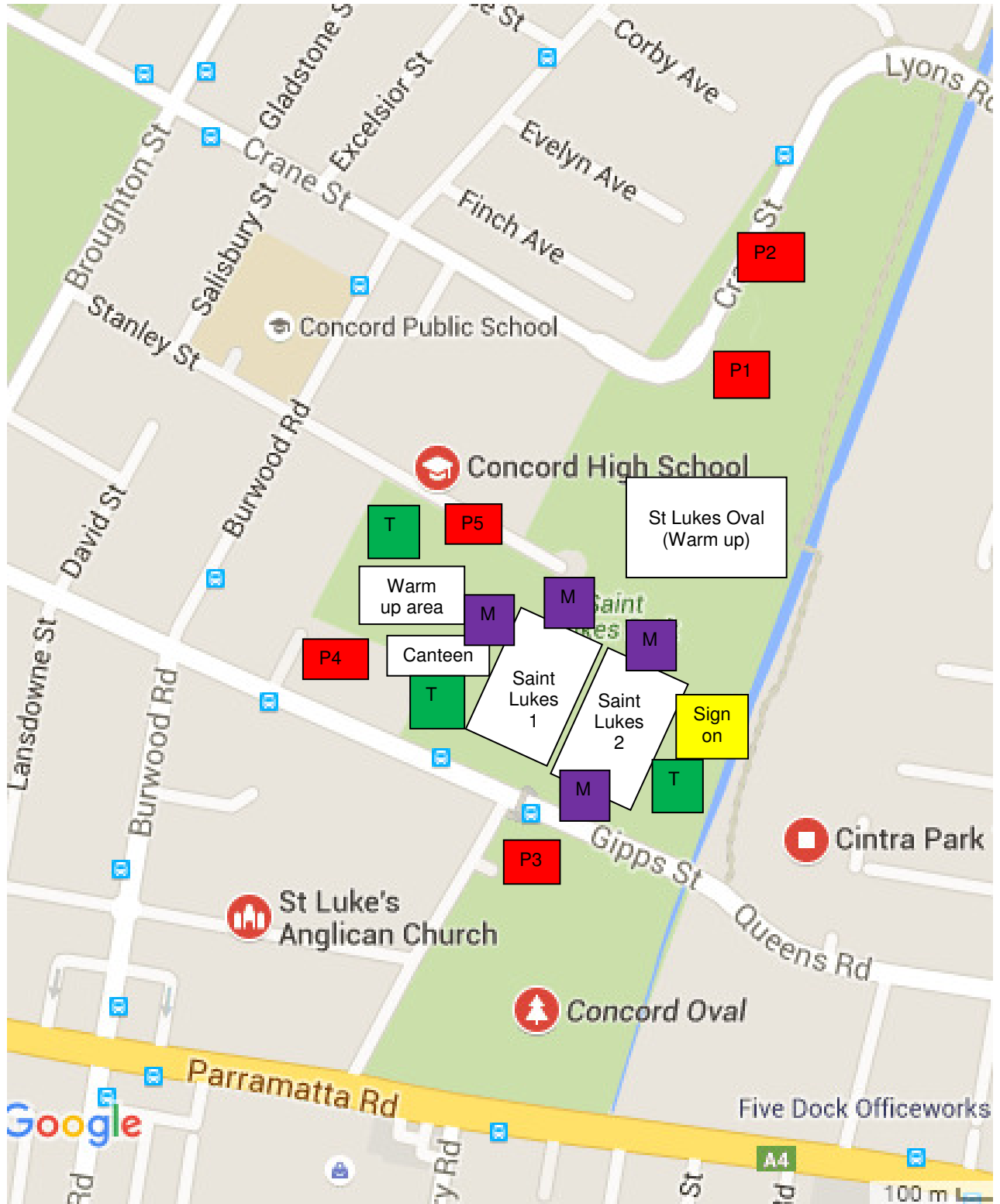
Medical Emergency: The nearest hospital is Concord Hospital, Hospital Road, Concord.

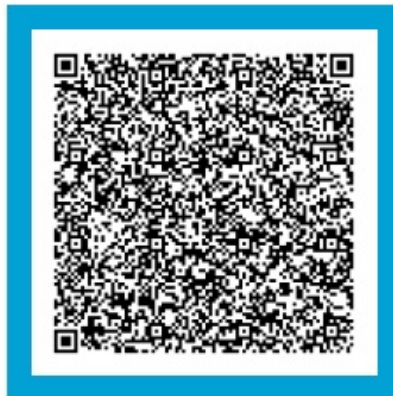
