Welcome

We are excited to welcome you to Apex Oval and the City of Dubbo, for the Under 13 State Championships.

Thank you to the referees and match officials for their time and dedication to officiate these matches.

Following is important information about the venue to ensure your visit to the complex and our beautiful city is an enjoyable one.

Code of Conduct

All team officials, players, parents and spectators must adhere to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct. There will be Zero Tolerance of abuse towards any match officials, anyone that breaches this code of conduct will be removed from the Championships and Grounds

Ground Marshalls

A Ground Marshall will be assigned to each field, and will be responsible for ensuring:

- all players and officials remain in designated zones;
- that the behaviour of players, officials and spectators adheres to the Rugby Australia Code of Conduct.

First Aid

There will be qualified First Aid Officers set up at each field should a Medical Emergency arise. Officers will be wearing a First Aid Vest and will be situated under a marquee with red table cloth identifying who they are.

The First Aid Officer will have ice on hand to be applied where appropriate for the treatment of injuries after the player has been assessed. Any player requiring ice must be seen by the First Aid Officer — ice will not be handed out.

Concussion: In the event of a player receiving a head or neck injury, or if any player is suspected of being concussed, the player must be referred to the First Aid officer.

Ambulances: Under no circumstances should any person on site call an ambulance.

The First Aid Officer will triage events, and call an ambulance if required. Medical

Emergency: The nearest hospital is Dubbo Base Hospital, Myall Street, Dubbo

QR CHECK IN

All persons entering the complex will be required to sign in to the venue using the Service NSW QR Code, located at each Gate. If you wish to check in prior to arrival, please do so using the code located on the final page of this document.

A reminder that if you are experiencing cold or flu like symptoms or have recently been to a known hot spot do not attend the Championships

Change Rooms & Amenities

Apex Oval has change rooms located in the centre of the main building, there will also be change rooms available at the secondary building on the southern side, both contain showers and toilet facilities

Toilets are located towards the Northern end of the main building and on the southern side of the secondary building.

Hand Sanitiser will be available at both Gates, along with other locations within the facility.

Laundromat

Laundromat facilities are available for teams to wash jerseys at The Wash House, 149a Cobra Street, open 6am until Midnight 7 days a week, cost is \$5.00 to \$10.00 per load dependent on size. Ph: 02 6884 3222

Canteen Facilities

Our U14 DJRC 2022 Touring Team will be facilitating the canteen and will have plenty of hot and cold options available. If you forget your cash no problem, they will have EFTPOS, no cash out will be available.

Marquees

Marquees are welcome, they will need to be set up outside of the fenced area on Field 1 and at least 8 metres from the playing area on Field 2 and outside of the spectator exclusion zone (marked in red). The Red Zone on the field map is for NSWJRU Officials and Teams participating on Field 2 only

Rubbish

Rubbish bins will be provided at multiple locations around the complex. Please ensure that your team area is cleaned at the end of each day.

Training Locations

For teams looking to have a training run Friday afternoon between 4pm – 8pm, we have 3 fields available at Katrina Gibbs Oval, located at the western end of Macleay Street, between Officeworks and Dubbo's Netball facilities. If you wish to make use of these fields, please contact Adam Willner on 0409 187 771 so he can allocate you a time and field. Limited spots available, note this if for Friday only.

Prohibited Items

Please be aware of the below prohibited items within the Apex Oval complex:

- BBQ, Cooking Facilities or implements of any kind
- Alcohol of any sort
- Glassware, including glass bottles, cups or glasses

If any of these items are found over the Championship weekend they will be confiscated and can be collected at the completion of the games on Monday, 14th June 2021
