PRE-OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENTS HAVING IV SEDATION/GENERAL ANESTHESIA

- You should have NOTHING to eat or drink six (6) hours prior to procedure. NOT EVEN
 WATER! You may have a "sip" of water if you are taking medication.
- 2. Use the Restroom just before the procedure.
- 3. Wear loose fitting, comfortable clothing with SHORT SLEEVES.
- DO NOT wear Contact Lenses, Jewelry, Make-up, Nail Polish, or Full Length Hose. No Hair clips or bows-LEAVE HAIR DOWN.
- **5.** Discontinue taking Aspirin or Aspirin products the day before surgery and the day of surgery, unless different instructions were given.
- **6.** After the procedure, limit your activity and rest as much as possible. You may feel sleepy or lightheaded for the rest of the day.
- 7. DO NOT drive a vehicle or operate machinery for 24-48 hours following the procedure.
- 8. A RESPONSIBLE DRIVER MUST BRING YOU, STAY DURING YOUR PROCEDURE, AND

 TAKE YOU HOME. You may NOT take a taxi, bus, or transport service. Driver CANNOT
 leave and come back to pick you up. **WE WILL NOT PERFORM SURGERY IF A

 RESPONSIBLE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE IS NOT PRESENT IN THE WAITING ROOM!!**
