

Merton Junior School Uniform and Presentation Policy 2015



Introduction

Recently governors have reviewed and identified the importance of high quality uniform and presentation of children at Merton Junior School. It is of importance that children are presented in a way that is suitable for school and this presentation is in line with the schools policy.

We ask you to ensure that your child attends school appropriately dressed so that he/she will develop a positive attitude towards school both as a community and as a place of work.

GIRLS:

Grey skirt or pinafore dress knee length or long trousers
Summer dresses in blue
Blue school jumper, cardigan or fleece
Blouse or polo shirt in white
Dark coloured shoes

BOYS

Grey long or short trousers
Blue school jumper or fleece
Shirt or polo shirt in white
Dark coloured shoes

Trainers are not acceptable for day-to-day footwear. Children can change into trainers for break times.

School fleeces and reversible jackets are also available on our uniform list.

P.E. Kit for boys and girls:

We promote good habits at Merton, all children will be expected to have a change of clothes for PE.

Dark shorts

Plain white T-shirt

Change of footwear for outside is essential (plimsolls or trainers)

In winter a track suit is advisable as we will still try and go out when ever weather permits.

A draw string bag

Book bags

All children will need a book bag which can be purchased from skoolkit. We ask that children do not bring rucksacks in to school as we do not have the space to store these.

Jewellery

Children are not to wear jewellery as this can cause safety problems during the school day. Small silver or gold stud earrings in the ear lobe and a watch are acceptable, but are worn at the owner's risk. No jewellery is allowed to be worn during PE under Hampshire Health & Safety guidelines.

Hair

We accept all children like to have different hair styles. At school the dying of hair is not acceptable, nor is significant shaved 'patterns' in hair. When participating in PE children with long hair will have to tie it up. If girls want to wear clips in their hair these need to be in colour or of a natural shade. We do not allow any girls to wear elaborate hair clips and they will be asked to remove these if they are worn to school.

Footwear

Children need to wear sensible black shoes in the school day, these shoes need to have a sensible sized heel that they are able to run around in. In the winter children are allowed to wear black boots. This does not include snow boots or UGGs. Children should be wearing black or white socks that are suitable for day-to-day activities at school. Trainers are not acceptable for day-to-day footwear. Children can change into trainers for break times

Make-up

Make-up, nail varnish or false nails at Merton are not allowed. If children turn up to school with make-up or nail varnish on they will be asked to remove it.

ALL UNIFORM SHOULD BE LABELLED CLEARLY WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.
