"64% of pupils reached the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths in 2018.

Attainment in all of reading, writing and maths (combined) is not directly comparable to previous years because of changes to writing TA frameworks. In 2017, 61% of pupils met the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths. In 2016, this figure was 53%.

To reach the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, a pupil must achieve a scaled score of 100 or more in reading and maths tests and an outcome of 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at greater depth' in writing TA.

In writing TA, the proportion of pupils who reached the expected standard in 2018 is 78%.

Changes made within the [2017/18 writing TA frameworks](#) mean judgements in 2018 are not directly comparable to those made using the previous interim frameworks in 2016 and 2017. In 2017, 76% of pupils met the expected standard in writing TA. In 2016, this figure was 74%.

To reach the expected standard in writing, a pupil must achieve an outcome of 'working at the expected standard' or 'working at greater depth' in writing TA."
