



## PE Premium (March 2014)



As part of the Governments initiative to improve the health and fitness of young people in schools Merton Junior School received a sports premium of £5348.00 this financial year (September 2013 - April 2014). We have used this money to pay for Planet Sport and Basingstoke Town Football Club to come and teach the children throughout the year.

A breakdown of this is as follows:

- Planet Sport = £872.67
- Basingstoke Town Football Club = £4499.50

Every Thursday our sports coaches spend the day in school teaching a wide variety of sports and games as per the new national curriculum for 2014.

The aim is for the children to be provided with quality PE teaching on a weekly basis, which ensures that the children are taught the four key skills within PE:

- Acquiring and developing skills:
- Selecting & Applying skills, tactics and compositional ideas:
- Evaluate & Improve Performance:
- Knowledge & Understanding of Fitness & Health

The coaches also provide our staff with the opportunity to observe good+ practice on a weekly basis. Our staff then incorporate what they have learnt and observed from Basingstoke Football club and apply it to their own lessons. In addition to this Basingstoke Football Club also provide our staff with specific coaching on areas they wish to develop.

Basingstoke Football club also run a lunchtime and after school club, which every child in the school is given the opportunity to attend.

After school clubs:

- Basketball
- Gymnastics club (this has been run for 2 terms now, due to its popularity).
- Benchball
- Cricket (Summer Term)

Lunchtime clubs:

- Football
- Rugby
- Skills for life (Summer term)



Merton Junior School has also been given a change for life bag, which Basingstoke Football club are using during their lunch time club. It is hoped that during the Summer term our Upper School children taking part in this club will run additional activities for the rest of the school at lunchtime.

Funding for April 2014 to April 2015 is £8755.
