Windmill Hill Residential Trip
Friday 14th June 2019 – Monday 17th June 2019
Parents meeting Wednesday 22nd May 3.30pm

The residential trip is approaching and there are a few items that are required from you before we go. The full balance is required by 31st March 2019 unless an arrangement has been made with the office. If you are having difficulty meeting the deadline please contact the office.

There are medical and photo consent forms to complete, which are attached to this letter and I have also attached a kit list. These forms must be returned by Friday 10th May 2019. Failure to return the forms will mean that your child can not attend the residential even if you have paid in full.

We have not been advised yet of the actual activities we are going to do, however they could consist of climbing, raft building, fencing, archery, high ropes and karting. These activities require the children to be able to move freely and at times wear safety harnesses. For this reason I do ask that the children wear sports clothing where possible and nothing with extra loops or tassels which could become caught in apparatus. Children with long hair need to have hair bands to keep their hair out of their faces and apparatus.

All the activities will take place regardless of the weather and so the number of items of clothing on the kit list is only a guide, please allow for changes should the children get wet.

A meeting has been arranged for Wednesday 22nd May at 3.30pm for parents and children to attend should you have any questions regarding the trip.
