

## Easter Activities Bingo

Here's some extra tasks for the Easter holidays. Cross them off when you've finished and show your teacher when you come back!

<p><u>Easter Crafts</u></p> <p>Create some Easter crafts using materials found in the home or local shop.</p> 	<p><u>Diary Entry</u></p> <p>Write a diary entry about getting your Easter eggs on Easter morning/eating your favourite Easter egg. How did you feel?</p>	<p><u>Nature Art</u></p> <p>Go on a local walk with your family (safely). Collect items on your walk – e.g. leaves, twigs (do not break anything that's alive!). Make an art mural documenting your walk. Can you make this Easter themed?</p>	<p><u>Easter Baking</u></p> <p>Melt some of your Easter egg chocolate and create cornflake/rice krispie cakes. Decorate your cakes with other Easter themed goodies e.g. mini eggs!</p> 
<p><u>Housekeeping</u></p> <p>Try helping at home! Try: Washing up Doing the laundry Hoovering Cleaning Helping to cook We would love to hear at school how you got on with it!</p>	<p><u>Narrative</u></p> <p>Write an adventure story about the journey the Easter bunny takes when delivering all the Easter eggs. Make it exciting with lots of action and suspense!</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Research the Easter story. Now create a way of presenting this information to the people at home e.g. a poster/presentation or your own story!</p>	<p><u>Easter Egg Hunt</u></p> <p>Create an Easter egg hunt for your family – with real or crafted eggs! If you like, write brief hints for them at each point to tell them where the next lot of eggs will be found...</p>
<p><u>Easter Cards</u></p> <p>Make and write Easter cards to people you know while you're not able to see them during this period of time. Let them know what you've been up to in the Easter holidays and any exciting things you want to tell them!</p>	<p><u>Easter Quiz</u></p> <p>Create an Easter quiz to play with your family. Research different facts that interest you about Easter. Write questions and multiple choice answers for your family to answer. See how much they know!</p>	<p><u>Comic Strip</u></p> <p>Make an Easter comic strip using cartoons of Easter characters. You could base this on the original Easter story or make your own with different characters e.g. the Easter bunny, Easter eggs etc.</p>	<p><u>Have an Easter party!</u></p> <p>Make some decorations, find a great playlist, use your Easter goodies as snacks and have a party with your family! Take lots of selfies and play musical games.</p>
