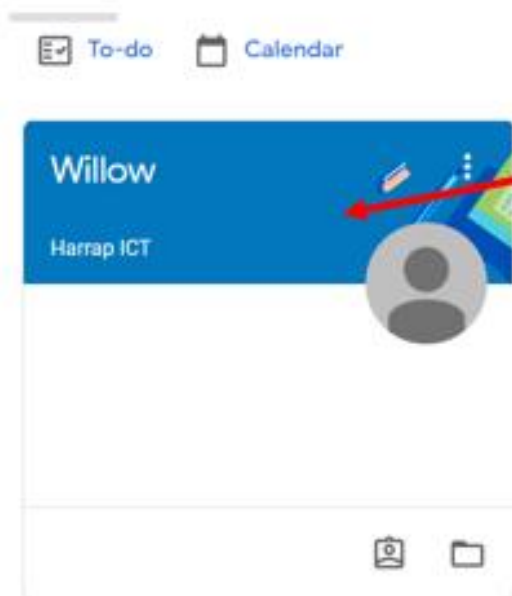


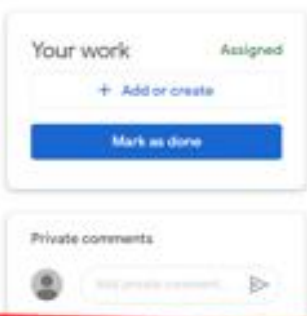
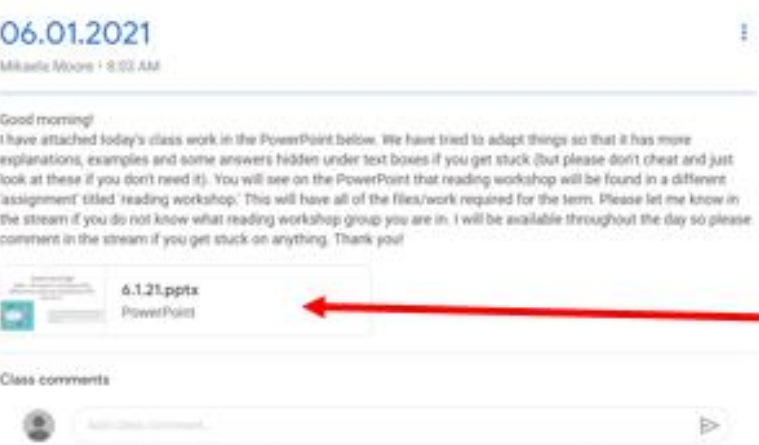
Opening, completing and submitting your work

Click on the ~~powerpoint~~ document

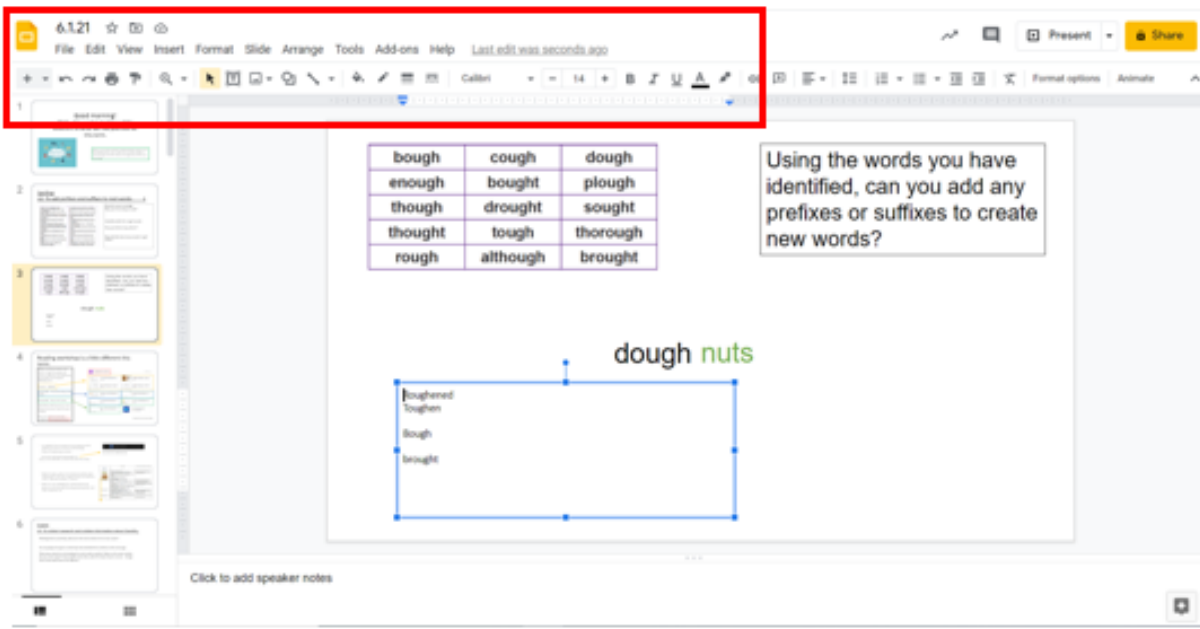


Good morning!

Your work should appear like this.

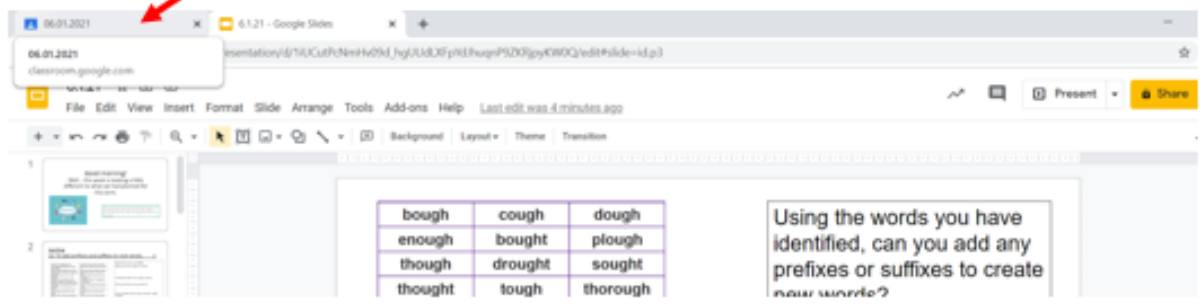
You can click insert > textbox, just like you would on Word and type your answers straight onto the ~~powerpoint~~.

It is exactly like the version of Word we have used lots in school.

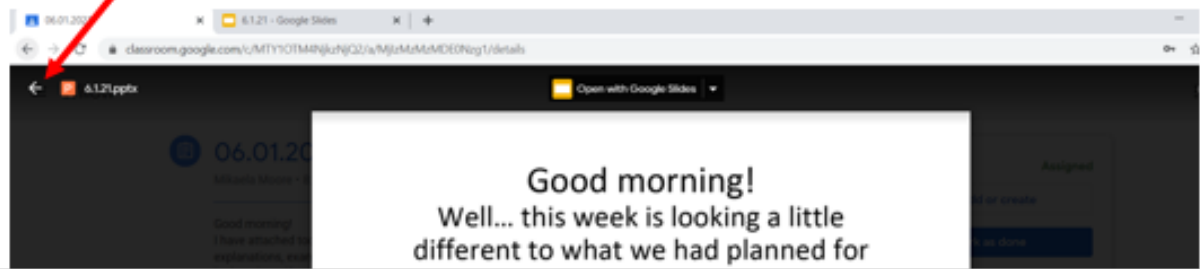
You can even add new slides to write on if there isn't much room.
