


Waterloo, New York Birthplace of Memorial Day




- Located in the heart of the beautiful Finger Lakes nestled between the two largest Finger Lakes; Seneca and Cayuga.

- The median household income is \$51,958.






Demographics of our Schools




Data

School Safety and Educational Climate Data (SSEC)


