




## **Alignment**

- ► Emphasis on "sustainability" and "efficiency"
- ➤ One major variable to sustained implementation of effective practices is the **introduction of new initiatives** that either:
  - a) compete with resources needed for sustained implementation
  - b) contradict existing initiatives (McIntosh)
