<b>Prep – 1</b>	\$3,820	<p><b>BASE RATE EXCLUSIONS</b> Base Rate Tuition Fees do not include the cost of uniforms, sporting equipment, excursions, camps (including music camps), outdoor education and extra activities, or costs as determined by the school. Additional costs will be subsidised by the school where possible. Occasionally, other opportunities for additional activities arise and costs associated with these activities are in addition to the fee schedule. Parent approval will be sought for such activities.</p> <p><b>ADDITIONAL YEARS 7-9 EXCLUSIONS</b> Base Rate Tuition Fees do not include books, stationary or laptop devices as these students participate in our BYOD program. Year 9 students must provide their own instrument to participate in our Vivace Special Entry Music Program.</p> <p><b>BUILDING AND MAINTENANCE LEVY</b> Building and Maintenance Levy requirement hours can be met through attendance at each term working bee or through the accumulation of individual housekeeping and ground tasks, eg, linen washing, window cleaning, weeding etc. to be completed in your own time. These allocations must be arranged and agreed upon with the College at the start of Term 1.</p>

Full-time bus use is considered as 6 or more trips per week. Part-time bus use (5 trips or less) is billed at 50% of the PA fee. Sibling discounts are only applied to full fare bus fees.

Billing and Payment	Uniforms
<p>Fees are billed annually and are payable in four instalments due by the end of week two of the school terms unless alternative arrangements are made. Fee plans are available; plans are flexible to meet each family's individual needs. Overdue accounts where there has been no communication with the college will attract an administration fee and an interest charge of 3% per term.
