2. There is an order dated January 28, 2019 passed in W.P.(MD) No.22163 of 2018 requiring a wholesome approach to be taken for removal of encroachment from waterbodies. Several directions were issued, including directions that had been issued earlier. However, new and newer encroachments in waterbodies appear to continue unabated.

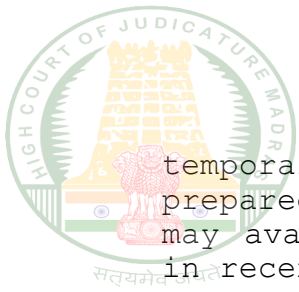
3. In another set of matters, the State has been required to obtain and catalogue satellite images of all waterbodies from the taluk level to the district and the State level, geo-reference the same and preserve it with a copy submitted to the High Court so that in future the Indian rope trick cannot be pulled on waterbodies and they cease to evaporate or disappear. Considerable time has been afforded to the State in such regard and it is hoped that the geo-referenced satellite images have been prepared upto the taluk level for each taluk to have its record of waterbodies, for every district to have the record of waterbodies of all taluks and for the appropriate department in the capital at Chennai to have all records pertaining to the districts. A copy of the complete catalogue should be available to be submitted to the High Court.

4. As far as the Chitlapakkam lake is concerned, it is submitted by the official respondents that 403 encroachers have been identified and steps initiated against them by issuing notices in Form-III. The individual noticees have challenged the notices and all the writ petitions appear in the list. The individual aspects have to be dealt with independently but, broadly speaking, some of the challenges refer to the relevant persons or their predecessors-in-interest having been in occupation for more than 50 years, some others refer to paying tax, obtaining electricity and paying for water for decades altogether, while others claim that they have been erroneously found to be in a different survey number than the survey number in which they are in occupation.

5. The State, on the other hand, submits that some of the occupants have stretched their areas of occupation to transgress from one survey number to another and seek to take advantage of such illegal exercise to suggest that the notices addressed to them pertain to the erroneous survey number.

6. What is of importance is that the occupants must be able to assert their right on the basis of documents of title. If there are no documents of title, the respective claims can scarcely be accepted.

7. At the same time, even if it is accepted that the occupants are rank trespassers who have willy-nilly settled into the edges of the waterbody, it is for the State to formulate a scheme for their rehabilitation. The waterbody has to be saved. The encroachers have to be removed. It would do well for the State to formulate a scheme under which the encroachers at the Chitlapakkam lake may be



temporarily accommodated at some place while permanent dwellings are prepared on a long-term basis. Again, only the long-term occupants may avail of this advantage, those of the encroachers who have come in recently may not be immediately entitled to be rehabilitated.

8. As a first step, all further attempt at encroachment should be dealt with in a strict manner by the State keeping a constant vigil. The encroachments in the larger waterbodies in the State may be dealt with in such manner as those in Chitlapakkam lake may now be and the State may consider this as a pilot project. It is imperative that in a State which does not have any perennial flowing water, the waterbodies and the channels of seasonal flowing water are left undisturbed, if only to ensure the future survival of the human race in this part of the world.

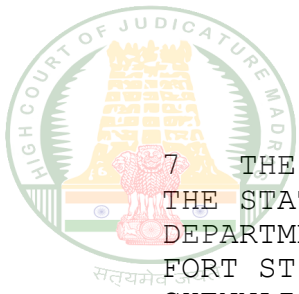

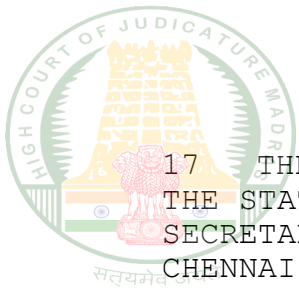
