Conferring of degrees in Sweden by World Maritime University

The World Maritime University (WMU) was established in 1983 through an agreement signed on 9 February 1983 between the International Maritime Organisation (IMO), a United Nations specialised maritime agency, and the Government of Sweden (Agreement Between the International Maritime Organisation and the Government of Sweden Regarding the World Maritime University). WMU is the IMO institution for maritime education and research, and IMO is responsible for the quality of the education that WMU provides in Sweden.

As part of IMO, WMU is an education provider that is independent of any individual national education system. WMU is operated by and for all IMO Member States.

WMU is entitled to conduct activities in Sweden under the agreement concluded between IMO and the Government of Sweden and the provisions of the Charter of the World Maritime University adopted by IMO for WMU activities in Sweden (A 26/Res. 1030). Under the provisions of this Charter, WMU has the power to confer degrees in Sweden.
