9) Youth Sports Report- Joe Horswell- Whiting Center Sports Update May 2020

BVS Hockey League – Due to Covid-19, Hockey League was terminated 3 weeks ahead of time, before playoffs and finals could be completed.

BVS Soccer League – We had a record number of 237 kids sign-up for Soccer this year, (we had 170 last year). Unfortunately, due to Covid-19, Soccer League was cancelled, and refund issued for all participants.

Beaubien Field – IGM completed the infield and outfield sprinkler system for Kodiak Field, and also installed sprinklers in left field on Cub Field. **Thanks to Brandon Warne Construction generously donated \$6000 to the BVSCRFF, and will also be designing, constructing, and installing an old school scoreboard on Kodiak Field. We are now moving forward with installing infield clay and sod, as well as outfield sod that will complete both Kodiak and Cub Fields.**

T-Ball – We are moving forward with T-Ball League in late June, and will be rolling out applications shortly. We will not be having a Rookie pitching machine division this year due to the ongoing work on Kodiak Field, however, we will be hosting pickup baseball for Rookie Division age kids on Friday nights, using coach pitch instead of a machine.

Baseball Camp – We are planning on having BVS Baseball Camp this year from July 20th – 23rd, and will be rolling out applications shortly.

Proposal to Expand Soccer Field #1 – is temporarily on hold due to the Kodiak field project.

10) Campground, Lakes, Parks Dept. 17 Update May 2020~Joe Horswell

Water Canyon Campground – Will be open to overnight camping on May 15th. Unfortunately, there have been 2 recent incidents of graffiti on the rocks in the area. Rangers are working hard to catch the perpetrators.
