Hello Bear Valley Springs,

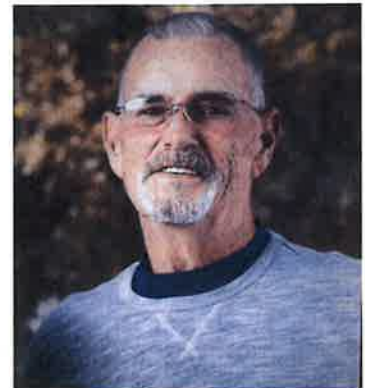
