- Pickle Ball & Tennis- work order in to clean lights on the courts for night play. The lift truck has to be repaired first. There is a work order to repair gates at courts.  
Free clinics sign -ups = Pickleball - 14 people, and 4 for tennis

- Beaubien Field / Nature Path- Brandon will be spraying a pre-emergent on the Nature path and dog park April 8th. They will be closed a half day to dry and then be watered in. This is not hazardous to animals but no one needs to track through it.

- Campgrounds -Water Canyon Campground will open May 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Lakes- 4-Island Lake is undergoing testing for high phosphorous levels most likely from years of affluent. The Association is considering treatment to keep the lake from excessive algae this summer.
  - Update on Rules for Picnic Table Reservation areas at 4 Island-There will be 4 group reservation areas at the East side of the parking lot at 4 Island Lake Park. The Picnic Tables at the Marina area will continue to be "First come First Serve" as advised by Wes Shryock. Amenity passes will continue to be checked.
