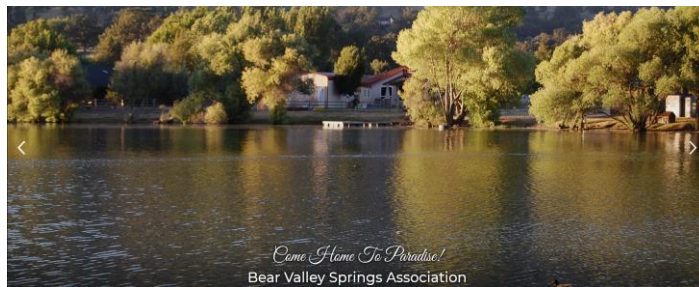

Due to severe drought conditions, the BVS Gun Range will be closed for fire season, beginning immediately. According to the U.S. Drought Monitor, the Tehachapi area and 95% of Kern County are rated at “D4 exceptional drought”, which is the most severe drought category. Daily temps at the Gun Range are regularly reaching 100+ degrees, with low humidity and breezy conditions. Other reasons compound the need to close the range, but the main issue is extreme fire danger. The BVS Gun Range will re-open in the fall months when we start to see precipitation again, and when the daily temps begin to drop.

POOL RULES

- **All Pool use is at your own risk. DO NOT USE if you are high risk or not in good health.**
- **Do Not move the patio furniture!**
- Health Breaks will be enforced every hour on the hour. Only Patrons 14 and up can swim during these 10 minutes. Might be more frequent if capacity is reached.
- **Each person 9 or older needs to show their Amenity Card at the pool gate.**
- Ice chests, coolers and similar containers shall not be brought into the pool area. However they can be left outside the gate. (BVSA Rule 1103)
- **NO GLASS OF ANY KIND.**
- **NO (scuba type) FACEMASKS ARE ALLOWED.**
- NO flips, twists, squirt guns, water balloons, hard balls, floaties, rafts, diving in shallow end, jumping in backwards, sitting on shoulders, climbing on rocks, or running.
- Children 14 and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult. Bring your children to the gate to ensure they are admitted. (BVSA Rule 1102c).
- A maximum pool capacity will be in effect.
- **Guests** will be charged a \$5 guest fee per day AND **MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PROPERTY OWNER!** Limit of 3 guests per Track/Lot 13 yrs. old & older. Children 5-12 are \$3; 4 under are free. Amenity Passes (without the resident) will NOT be honored.
- All swimmers may be required to prove swimming.
- Property Owners must be in good standing.

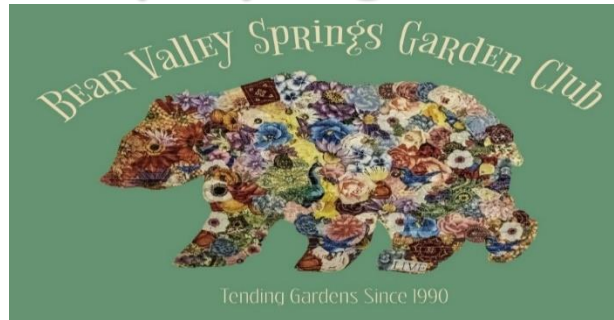

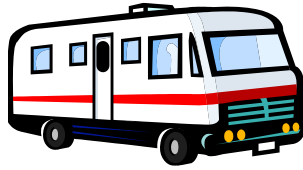
