1) Beaubien Field –Gary Adams

2) Nature Path: Kimberly Clow: Road base continues to be added to path! **REQUEST: Please have the potholes at the 2 entry driveways to Beaubien Field filled with rock and road base! Cars that are low cannot get into driveway easily.**

3) RC Modelers-Tom Papac-Is there a timeline when the water line will be run from Beaubien Field to the trees, Horse water trough and RC Modelers track?

- Would be nice to get a picnic table at the RC track viewing area. Update is that we are putting into the budget for next year to purchase 4 recycled plastic tables for the Model Facility.
