Valentine's Day Soda Can Shoot

The Sportsman's Club will be holding a Valentine's Day Shooting Festival on Saturday February 12th, at the Bear Valley Shooting Ranges, starting at 10am. The targets will be out of date soda cans and all shooters are invited to bring their guns and help dispose of these cans. You can bring rifles or pistols of any caliber and also air rifles / pistols. The only restriction is that ammunition must safe to use on the range.

The event is open to all Bear Valley residents and there is no charge to take part. There are no prizes but you can always take home the cans you have shot and mount them on your trophy wall! We plan to have a few guns available that can be borrowed if you do not have a gun of your own but we will ask you to pay for the ammunition that you use. If you have your own gun and ammunition, then bring it along. A .22 RF gun is more than adequate for this shoot but larger and smaller calibers can be used, especially for those sneaky cans at the back end of the range! All shooters need to have the 2022 Range Safety sticker on their amenity cards (don't forget to bring your card on the day). If you have not got this sticker, just call in at the Whiting Center to complete the formalities.

This is a fun shoot suitable for adults and children alike but children must be supervised by a parent or guardian whilst shooting. You can bring non-resident guests but they will be required to pay the guest range fee and you will be responsible for ensuring they shoot safely.

We do place an emphasis on safety and the safe handling of guns, so there will be a Range Briefing at 10am before shooting starts but this will not interfere with your enjoyment of the event. The satisfying sight of a soda can exploding in a fizzy shower when hit is as satisfying as it is spectacular.

After we have finished shooting, we will have some Hot Dogs to put on the BBQ and you can bring along your own food if you wish. We will also have in-date sodas to quench your thirsts! We look forward to an enjoyable day on Saturday.

The Shoot will start at 10.00am with a safety briefing and continue until all the cans have been successfully perforated. Remember to give yourself time to get to the range as it takes 30 minutes to get there from the bottom of Deer Trail.

After the Shoot, we will have Hot Dogs and not-out-of date sodas available for all. If you want to bring your own food to throw on the BBQ, you are most welcome.


