



Bear Valley Buckaroos

Our big news this year is that we are now the host club for the BV Buckaroos AMA Mule and Horse Show on August 5th, 6th, & 7th. This show has become a Bear Valley tradition and is a great spectator event. Full details can be found on the Bear Valley Buckaroos Facebook page.

Our first playday was held on Saturday, June 18^{th} , and we had a huge turnout. Playdays are fun & challenging for riders of all ages and will be held on the 2^{nd} Saturday of the month through October.

Our first team sorting "round robin" competition was held on Sunday, June 19th, with 90 teams competing for the prize money and end of season buckles. The competitions will continue on the 2nd Sunday of each month through October. There will be cash pay outs to the top 3 riders in each group of 10, with both morning & afternoon sessions.

Practice sessions with our cattle will be held at 5:00 pm on Wednesdays & Saturdays through October. Practice will not be held on the Saturday prior to a competitive team sorting. Practice is fun and non-competitive. Riders of any level, beginner to advanced, are welcome to practice at their own speed. There is a \$30 fee per rider for each practice session.

We have already held a successful barrel racing clinic and we have a 2-day horsemanship and cattle work clinic scheduled for July 16th & 17th. The clinic is limited to 10 people per day and spots are still available for either or both days.






